9th RAJASTHAN ENERGY CONSERVATION AWARDS – 2018

OBJECTIVE:

The objective of the energy conservation award scheme is to give special state level recognition for the conscious and systematic efforts put in by the industries/establishments/individuals for efficient utilisation and measurable conservation of energy during the years 2017-18. This continual promotional award scheme starting from the year 2009 is constituted for motivation, replication and creating awareness for energy conservation in all major sectors of energy usage.

THE AWARDS:

First and second prizes are proposed for each category in the form of Trophy/plaque with appropriate citation and a certificate for the achievements.

The award committee would however take a final decision on the number of awards depending on the number and quality of the entries received in each category. It may therefore not be necessary to give first, second awards in each sector.

An excellence award shall be constituted subsequently for the units who get first prize for three consecutive years.

ELIGIBILITY:

- a) The scheme is applicable only for the establishments/units located in the Rajasthan State.
- b) If any establishment/unit does not fall under any of the specified sub-sectors than the unit can participate under 'General category'.

CATEGORIES:

A) Industrial units in the sub-sectors of Large/Medium scale industries of the following.

- Energy Conservation Building Directives compliant buildings

- D) Special scheme for recognising the best work done in energy conservation/creating awareness by
- Municipalities/Municipal councils
 - Energy forums/clubs in University/Colleges/Schools.
 - Energy Auditors for the work done in Rajasthan State.
 - Individuals/entities for their dedication and quantifiable work done to promote energy conservation in Rajasthan state.
 - Best original, innovative and practical suggestion from residents of Rajasthan for Energy Conservation measures which should be implemented at State level.
 - Government Departments for outstanding EC initiatives

CRITERIA FOR JUDGING MERIT

- 1) Filled in questionnaire (as per the instruction below) would form the basis for preliminary short listing amongst the participants. The evaluation criteria would be as per annexure D of the award scheme.
- 2) The selection committee may invite some of the selected units for giving presentations at RRECL, Jaipur or Secretariat, Jaipur before finalising the list of award winning units. The participating units would have to bear all expenses on this account.
- 3) The members of the award committee or their nominees may visit the participating short listed units for verification of data supplied, if felt necessary and it would be obligatory on the part of the participating units to provide complete co-operation.
- 4) The committee's decision would be final and binding.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING UP THE 'AWARD QUESTIONNAIRE'

- 1) The data required for the questionnaire pertains to the last two accounting years. If the calendar year is the accounting year, then data should pertain to the last two calendar years.
- 2) The enclosed questionnaire is only a format and thus information sought should be separately computer printed or neatly typed or to be downloaded from the RRECL's web site energy.rajasthan.gov.in/rrecl. It can also be posted to the participant on request.
- 3) The answers to the questions should be precise and specific and should be supplied in total compliance with the questionnaire format. The deviations may lead to improper evaluation or rejection of the nomination.
- 4) The information sought under any heading should be highlighted under the same and no separate annexure should be attached.

- 5) Each and every query mentioned in the questionnaire needs to be answered. Even if the answer is 'NO' or 'NOT APPLICABLE' the same may be stated, instead of ignoring it.
- 6) The questionnaire should be filled in by a competent and responsible person of the company. He/She should be fully conversant with the energy terms and units, conversions/multiplying factors etc. The duly filled in questionnaire should be signed by the Chief Executive of the establishment.
- 7) The questionnaire can be circulated to sister units, other industrial units for wider participation.
- 8) RRECL will be authorised to use the information submitted through questionnaire for compilation of energy saving data, analysis and subsequent usage for awareness or other similar utility.
- 9) Canvassing in any form shall automatically disqualify the participant.
- 10) Units located in the same premises are to be clubbed together in single entity unless registered as separate Designated Consumers with Bureau of Energy Efficiency
