**ORDER**

In supersession to all previous orders issued regarding norms of Vigilance Checking, the following monthly targets (minimum) which are existing for O&M officers of Jaipur Discom are hereby prescribed for all the officers of O&M wing of Ajmer Discom as well as Jodhpur Discom with immediate effect.

The performance of each O&M officer shall be evaluated as per following method-

- 20% of actual effective checking's.
- 20% of actual theft detection.
- 20% of actual amount of assessment.
- 20% of actual amount of realization.
- 10% of actual FIRs registered in APTPS with respect to the eligible cases.

**Note:** On registration of additional FIR(s), 0.5% bonus mark shall be given to the checking officer on each such FIR. The checking officer(s) may ensure that the FIR actually registered in APTPS be only counted in the monthly progress report.

- In theft cases, where compounding charges are not deposited by defaulting consumer/ non-consumer or theft is detected for the second/ subsequent time in the same premises by the same consumer, needful legal action should be initiated by lodging a FIR in the concerned Police Station.

2. To develop the source information for detection of energy theft, wide publicity of incentive scheme for informers be given in order to achieve the targets and motivate the general public as well.
3. The targets for O&M officers have been slightly increased to bring uniformity in all Discoms. It is expected that these new set targets will be exceeded by O&M officers.
4. The XEN O&M will be the Nodal Officer in respect of Vigilance Checking work done by O&M sub ordinate officers in the division. He will ensure the feeding of individual VCR drawn by checking officers in the computer provided with him, so as to monitor the fate of each VCR in regard to assessment, realization and lodging of FIR etc. This will also facilitate in generating all type of Computer bases information.
5. The SE (O&M) will compile and send the monthly performance report of Vigilance Checking carried out by O&M Officers in the enclosed format (Annexure-I) by 5<sup>th</sup> of following month to the Addl. S. P.(Vig.) and ZCE/ CE (O&M) concerned.
6. The ZCE (O&M) will monitor and analyze the performance of the officers under his jurisdiction and will keep the CMD/ MD of respective Discorn apprised of the progress.
