Sub-Directions issued during Video-Conference held on 18th Dec., 2012.

A Video Conference of field officers of Three Discom was held on 18.12.2012, wherein the circle wise performance regarding reduction in AT&C losses, replacement of defective meters, release of connections, supply position in rural / urban areas, replacement of burnt / defective transformers, recovery of old dues under EUDR/LR Act and Vigilance Activities were discussed.

The Chairman Discoms expressed concern over the progress and said that the field officers are not complying with the instructions issued during various V.Cs, Sr. Officers, HODs and other meetings. Although detailed directions have already been issued from time to time, but it is felt that field officers are not giving due importance and working as per their sweet will. The Chairman Discoms directed to prepare action plan on all directions issued by the corporate office time to time and send compliance status within a fortnight to the undersigned.

Some of the important directions imparted during Video Conferencing are reiterated as under:-

- 1) During the Rabi Season, power supply for agriculture purpose shall be regulated strictly in day & night blocks as per detailed instructions issued by the Director (PT) in such a way that maximum load (60%) will be catered in night blocks. All SEs were directed to ensure 6 hours 3 phase supply for agriculture and 24 hours single phase supply for rural domestic areas.
- 2) It was emphasised that the T&D losses upto Oct. 12, of all three Discoms, have increased as compared to previous year, and most of the circles had not achieved the target also, which is not tolerable. All officers were directed to analysis the data and pin point the area of concern and put their all out efforts to bring down the T&D /AT&C losses below the targeted limit fixed for their circle for the year 2012-13. Similar action be also be taken at each sub-divisional level.
- 3) The T&D losses of Alwar, Bharatpur, Dausa, Karauli, Jaipur District, Sawaimadhapur, Banswara, Dungarpur, Chhitorgarh, Jhunjhunu, Barmer, Jodhpur District, Jalore, Bikaner & Hanumangarh circles, were found excessively high as compared to last year upto the month. The concerned SEs were directed to send a detailed note with analysis and action taken report to bring down the losses below the targeted level.



- 4) All SEs were directed to prepare an action plan and stick on that regularly to reduce the ATC losses in urban areas.
- 5) All circle SEs were directed to achieve cent percent realisation against the assessment of the year 2012-13. They should make all out efforts and ensure that this target is achieved. It was also reiterated that a vehicle with manpower has already been approved 5 months back. All the sub-divisions should utilize such vehicles / manpower for revenue recovery also.
- 6) The Circle SEs will arrange to expedite and ensure that the meter reading of each & every defective meter received from site is captured by digital cameras / HHT. The captured reading is verified from the last reading for which bills have been issued. If, there is some discrepancy, the difference be debited / credited in the consumer account with proper intimation / instructions to the consumer and billing agency.
- 7) All notices under EUDR/LR Act be served through concerned APTPS for the PDC consumers having outstanding more than Rs. 50,000/- . The Addl. S.P.(Vig.) will monitor & make necessary arrangement to serve the notices to the defaulting consumer and to collect the information regarding the property of defaulting consumers which can be attached to recover the dues.
- 8) The ASP (Vigilance) will arrange 100% physical verification of sites of the PDC consumers (as per list provided by the XEn having outstanding dues more than Rs. 50,000.0
- 9) The ASP (Vigilance) will also ensure the following:
 - a) At least 25 numbers of FIRs are lodged every month against the PDC consumers whose connections are found reconnected at site during the physical verification.
 - b) Immediate action against the consumers / non-consumers being found indulged in theft of energy etc. be initiated and arrange to arrest them.
 - c) Assist the XENs in attachment process of properties of the defaulting consumers / non consumers.
 - d) Weekly information be sent to Corporate Office and CE / ZCE (O&M) regarding number of cases detected under Section-135 & 138(1st time & 2nd time) of Electricity Act,2003 and number of arrest(s) made.
- 10) All SEs were directed to arrange to replace all defective meters in their jurisdiction. The SE (O&M) will send the weekly information to CE (O&M) regarding the number of meters changed during the week, number of reading(s) captured with reason for not capturing the reading of 100% meters received and number of additional units charged on account of discrepancies noticed in reading recorded by the Meter Reader and captured by HHT etc.

- 11) It was gathered that the work of meter reading verification by the field officers are not being carried out. The Chairman Discoms expressed his displeasure and asked the field officers to verify the meter readings as per target every month.
- 12) The ASP (Vigilance) were directed to arrange special vigilance drive in difficult areas of Dholpur, Bharatpur, Dausa, Karauli, Jhalawar & Baran circles.
- 13) All XENs of O&M will attach the property of at least 3 defaulting consumers upto 31st Dec., 2012 and thereafter one attachment per month. Respective CAOs will monitor the progress and Director (Finance) will put up progress every month. The CE (O&M) will monitor and report the progress by 5th of every month and send the corporate office.
- 14) All SEs / XENs were directed to put all out efforts to reduce T&D losses well below previous year & intimate the measures taken for this purpose.

All concerned officers are directed to ensure the compliance of the above directions and submit compliance report within 7 days.


