ORDER

Sub :- Voluntary advance deposition scheme for availing relief in the DPS to be levied and saving disconnection.

Number of consumers like Vodaphone, Airtel, Reliance, Spencer and Vishal Mega Mart etc. having large number of mobile tower/ stores connections across the Discom have represented to Nigam that due dates of their various energy bills falls on different dates during a month, Non receipt /delay in receipt of bills (due to their own reasons) cause delay in deposition of energy bills and attracts DPS besides disconnection, several times. This issue came for discussion in a high level meeting held on 7th August,-09, when the CMD desired to introduce a voluntary advance deposition scheme for allowing relief in the DPS to be levied and saving from disconnection, in case such consumers fails to deposit their energy bills on due dates. Accordingly, the scheme is here prescribed, as per provisions mentioned hereunder:-

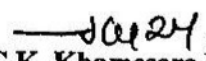
1. The consumer intends to avails this facility has to deposit an interest free advance equal to the aggregate amount of it's all the bills issued during the month of July-09/ Aug-09 with the AEn concerned. Advance so deposited is subject to further review every year, during the month of September.
2. The AEn concerned will receive such amount under "Advance Deposit against Consumption Charges" through A-9.
3. No DPS will be levied against such connections, provided the payment of such bills is made up to the month end of the bills due. However, this benefit will be allowed from the next month in which such advance has received.
4. In case of non deposition of bills up to the month end of bills due DPS will be levied and action of disconnection will also be taken as per prevailing provisions.
5. This scheme is purely a voluntary scheme and consumer/company who is having a number of connections in the Discom can opt for this scheme. It is felt that scheme would be beneficial for companies like Vodaphone, Airtel, Reliance, Reliance Fresh, Vishal Mega Mart etc. which are having a number of connections scattered all over the State.

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6. Advance amount deposited by the consumer shall be kept intact, and it will be adjusted when the consumer withdraw himself from the scheme, but not less than one year period from the date of scheme opted by the consumer.

This order will come into force with immediate effect.

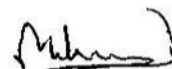
