ORDER

The Rajasthan Electricity Regulatory Commission has passed an order on dt. 24-03-2001 and directed vide Para-141 that energy audit is to be undertaken in each revenue circle by metering the energy supplied on all 11 KV feeders, to ascertain the gap between the energy supplied and billed from that feeder.

Therefore to implement the above direction of RERC, metering equipment are to be installed on all the 11 KV feeders, for recording the energy transmitted to various distribution LT feeders. The Superintending Engineer (O&M) concerned will be the overall in-charge, to execute the above work of installing meters etc. through his field staff and officers. The Executive Engineer, Asstt. Engineer and Jr. Engineer concerned will be responsible for reducing the gap between the energy supplied and energy billed after ensuring adequate metering on all 11 KV feeders within their jurisdiction. The Executive Engineer (MT) is hereby assigned the work to take the reading of energy available on all the 11 KV feeders emanating from S/S simultaneously, as per the reading program of that particular feeder. The Executive Engineer (MT) will also analyse the gap between energy supplied and billed in consultation with the billing agency and furnish his report with suggestions to the Superintending Engineer (M&P) every month.


The Superintending Engineer(M&P) is appointed as Nodal Officer for the work of energy audit. He will furnish his analytical report every quarter to the undersigned and to the F.A.& C.O.A., to examine the facts and onward transmission to the Regulatory Commission. After ascertaining the gap between the energy supplied & billed, the



Superintending Engineer (O&M) concerned, will take suitable corrective steps to minimise the gap between energy billed and energy supplied by way of augmenting the existing system and to curb the theft of power through intensive vigilance checking program. The above activity should be performed in a time bound manner, to achieve the goal.

All concerning officers / officials shall take the necessary steps to own the responsibility to minimise the losses of energy.

This order shall be in force with immediate effect.
