## Order

**Sub: - Regarding Self-certification of installation of generating units.**

The Central Electricity Authority (Measures relating to Safety and Electric Supply) Regulation, 2010 as amended from time to time stipulates as under:

“The capacity above which generating units including generating units producing electricity from renewable sources of energy will be required to be inspected by the Electrical Inspector before commissioning shall be as per the notification to be issued by the Appropriate Government under the sub-section (1) of section 162 of the Act.”

In view of above, State Government has issued a Notification on dated, March 21, 2016 and published in official gazette of Rajasthan on dated March 28, 2016, which is reproduced as below:

### **NOTIFICATION**

**Jaipur, March 21, 2016**


In exercise of powers conferred by Regulation 32 of the Central Electricity Authority (Measures relating to Safety and Electric Supply) Regulation, 2010 as amended from time to time, the State Government, with immediate effect, hereby notifies:

- (i) that no electrical generating units, including those producing electrical energy from renewable sources of energy having capacity above 1 MVA without the inspection of the Electrical Inspector shall be energized and the owner shall give 30 days notice of his intention to commission the units to the inspector;

- (ii) that the generating units having capacity above 100 KVA and upto 1 MVA, shall be self-certified with assistance of Chartered Electrical Safety Engineer or certified by an Electrical Inspector as may be opted by the owner;
- (iii) That the generating units having capacity upto 100 KVA shall be self-certified or certified by an Electrical Inspector as may be opted by the owner; and
- (iv) that notwithstanding anything contained in clause (i), (ii) & (iii) above, the Chief Electrical Inspector and Electrical Inspector shall have the power to take appropriate action under the Rajasthan Chief Electrical Inspector and Electrical Inspector (Power and Functions) Rules, 2016.
