ORDER

Sub:- Analyzing the out-put datas provided by the meter reading agencies by M&P Wing.

In the year 2013-14, the work relating to capturing meter reading through CMRI and analysis of meter data and load survey of all HT/MIP-I/MIP-II/Large Industrial/ Other Industrial Consumers provided with down loadable ABT meter/HT-TVM/Static LT-TVM/Whole current meter was out sourced. As per the scope of the work, the outside agencies are required to generate various reports and output datas through software and the same are required to be made available to the respective SE (M&P), SE(O&M), XEN(M&P) and XEN (O&M), besides to the respective designated billing officer/agency. The detailed description of these verification and load survey reports/output reports have been given in the work orders placed on the agencies. Therefore, the above mentioned officers are expected to thoroughly read, analyse and there of communicate any deviations along with action to be taken to the respective officers, besides to the billing agency.

But, it has been noticed that either these reports are not being generated and furnished by the outside agencies or in case furnished, then the same are not being seriously read and analysed. More so, as per the contract awarded to these agencies, the respective XEN (M&P), has to record a certificate to the effect that the meter reading/capturing agency has provided all the required reports and performance of the agency has been found satisfactory, at the line of verifying the bills furnished by these agencies. Only after having furnished this certificate the bills furnished by the agency are to entertained by the respective designated billing officer. But unfortunately these certificates are also being recorded routinely/casually without giving any serious thought to this otherwise very serious and vulnerable area.

In light of the above, it is enjoined upon all concerned XEN (M&P), to be very particular about the reading analyzing of the outputs details/ report and forthwith communicating any variation to their counterpart O&M officers along with the respective designated billing officer/agency.

Hence, this may invariably be kept in view that in case any lapse/ carelessness in this regard is detected and brought to notice, then the same shall attract disciplinary action against officer (s) at default.
