Sub:- Action to be taken regarding court cases.

Meeting of L.As. was held on 03.12.09 while Director (Finance), AVVNL, Ajmer was also present and some decisions were taken. It is therefore requested to implement following points:-

- 1 Many court cases are lost due to in-complete & ambiguous replies. It was pointed out that concerning officer(s)/official(s) do not furnish relevant record in time, which cause delay & difficulty in preparing comprehensive reply.
It has been decided that the concerned officer/official viz. the ARO/JEN/Meter Reader/Ledger Keeper etc. of the office, who keeps such record, should be made responsible to make available relevant record & factual position to the concerned OIC, well in time.
- 2 Most of the cases are lost due to procedural lapses. The officer(s)/official(s) should have complete knowledge of the law/orders/circulars/policies of Nigams should strictly follow the procedure, laid down, therein.
- 3 Special care should be taken in the cases of Theft of Electricity under section 135 to 140 and unauthorized use of electricity under section-126 of the Act and due procedure should be adopted. VCR should be filled in properly & due process of provisional assessment, opportunity of hearing, final assessment etc. should be adopted in the cases of unauthorized use of electricity under section 126 of the Act. In the cases of theft of electricity under section-135, separate notice should be issued & if compounding amount is not deposited within 7 days, FIR/Complaint should be filed, as the case may be.

- ④ Information of cases in favour and against the Nigam, should be prepared every month. The Superintending Engineer concerned should make proper analysis of the cases lost and try their best to overcome lapses/short-comings.
5. The L.A., Udaipur & Bhilwara intimated that the courts refer the cases to Settlement Committee, on request. All L.As. & OICs should try their best so that respective courts refer the cases to Grievance Redressal Committee of Nigam, where the cases should be heard.
- ⑥ Regarding computer facility to circle Legal Cell, it was decided that Superintending Engineers should allot time slaught to the Legal Cell to share with the computers of Personnel Officer/or other computer of circle office.

It is therefore requested to implement the decisions taken in the meeting of L.As. as mentioned above.
