ORDER-127

**Sub:- Grant of Dearness Allowance to AVVNL
Employees.**

In exercise of the powers conferred vide order No. AVVNL / CAO / Rules / F. 1 (3) / D. 505 dated 03.11.2001, the Managing Director, AVVNL, Ajmer has been pleased to adopt the State Government's order No. F. 7 (1) FD (Rules) / 98 dated 14.10.2004, accordingly, the existing rate of Dearness Allowance payable to the employees vide this office order No. AVVNL / CAO / AAO (Rules) / F. 1 (3) / D. 512 dated 18.05.2004 shall be revised w.e.f. 1.07.2004 as under:-

- i) Out of 61% Dearness Allowance sanctioned vide order referred above 50% has been treated as Dearness Pay w.e.f. 1.7.2004 and remaining 11% of Dearness Allowance shall be admissible on basic pay as per order No. AVVNL / CAO / Rules / F & R / F. 1 (3 / 4) / D. 900 Ajmer dated 21.06.2004.
- ii) Dearness Allowance @ 3% w.e.f. 1.07.2004 shall be admissible on total of Basic Pay plus Dearness Pay.

The term "Basic Pay" for the purpose of calculation of Dearness Allowance shall be the pay as defined in Regulation 3 (XVII) (a) of Employees Service Regulations drawn in the revised Pay Scale prescribed vide erstwhile PSEB order No. PSEB / F & R / P. 46 (21) (iii) / D. 11 dated 24.02.1998, as amended from time to time and shall not include any other types of pay like special pay or Personal pay etc. In case of those employees who opt to remain in the existing scale of pay, it will include, in addition to pay in the pre-revised scale, Dearness Allowance and interest relief appropriate to that pay admissible under orders in existence on 1.1.1998.

The payment on account of Dearness Allowance involving fraction of 50 Paise and above may be rounded off to the next higher rupees and the fractions of less than 50 Paise may be ignored.

The amount of increased Dearness Allowance and its arrear will be paid as follows:-

- i) The existing rate of Dearness Allowance may be increased from 61% to 64% w.e.f. 1.7.2004 and it shall be payable in cash w.e.f. 1.12.2004 i.e. salary for the month of December-2004 payable on 01.01.2005.
- ii) The orders relating to payment of arrears from July-2004 to November-2004 will be issued separately.

The payment of Dearness Allowance will also be subject to the terms and conditions laid down in the Rules for drawl of Dearness Allowance given in Appendix XVI of the R.S.R. Volume -II.

The increased Dearness Allowance shall also be admissible and paid in cash to those employees who were in service on or after 1.7.2004 but cease to in service prior to the issue of this order, whether for disciplinary reasons or on account of resignation, retirement, death or discharge or abolition of sanctioned post.
