ORDER-143

Sub:- Payment of arrears of enhanced Dearness Allowance for the period 1.7.2004 to 30.11.2004 to the employees of AVVNL.

1. The rates of Dearness Allowance was revised / increased from 61% to 64% w.e.f. 1st December, 2004 (payable in January, 2005) vide this office order No. No. AVVNL / CAO / AAO (F & R) / F. 1(3) / D. 2584 Dated 03.12.04 (Order - 127) with the instructions that order for drawal of arrears for the period from 1.7.2004 to 30.11.2004 will be issued separately.
2. The Managing Director is pleased to order that the arrears of Dearness Allowance 61% to 64% for the period from 1.7.2004 to 30.11.2004 be paid to the employees in the following manner:-
 - A. In respect of employees drawing basic pay upto Rs. 10,500/- per month; the arrears may be paid in two equal installments alongwith salaries for the month of April, 2005 and May, 2005.
 - B. In respect of employees drawing basic pay above Rs. 10,500/- per month, the arrears shall be credited to their GPF account or invested in PPF / NSCs as per authorization by them in two installments as indicated above at (A).
3. The term "Pay" for the purpose of calculation of arrears of Dearness Allowance shall be the pay as defined in Regulation 3 (xviii) (a) of Employees Service Regulations drawn in the Revised Pay Scale prescribed vide erstwhile RSEB order No. RSEB / F & R / F. 46 (21) (iii) / D. 11 dated 24.02.1998, as amended from time to time and shall not include any other type(s) of pay like special pay or Personal pay etc. In case of those employees who opt to retain in the existing scale of pay, it will include, in addition to pay in the pre-revised scale, Dearness Allowance and interim relief appropriate to that pay admissible under orders in existence on 1.1.1996.
4. The payment on account of Dearness Allowance involving fraction of 50 paise and above may be rounded off to the next higher rupees and the fractions of less than 50 paise may be ignored.




