Jaipur, 12th September, 2005 (Amended upto Reg. 59 dated 12.1.07 – third amendment)

No: RERC/Secy/ Reg. 37- In exercise of the powers conferred under Section 181 of the Electricity Act, 2003 read with Section 64(1) and 86(g) of that act, regulation 2 of the Rajasthan Electricity Regulatory Commission (Transaction of Business) Regulations 2004 & regulations 21(2) & 59 to 61, 70 of Rajasthan Electricity Regulatory Commission (Conduct of Business) regulations and all powers enabling it in that behalf, the Rajasthan Electricity Regulatory Commission, hereby makes the following regulations, namely;

General

1. Short title and commencement

- (1) These Regulations may be called the Rajasthan Electricity Regulatory Commission (**Fees for Petitions**) Regulations, 2005.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official gazette.

2. Definitions

- (1) In these regulations unless the context otherwise requires,
 - (i) "Act" means the Electricity Act, 2003 (36 of 2003).
 - (ii) "ARR" means the expected Aggregate Revenue Requirement as specified in clause 3 of RERC (Terms & Conditions for Determination of Tariff) Regulations, 2004
 - (iii) "Commission" means the Rajasthan Electricity Regulatory Commission.
 - (iv) "Generation Capacity" means installed capacity as per name plate rating of generating units of power plant
 - (v) "Intra-state trading" means the buying and selling of electricity by an electricity trader within the territory of the State of Rajasthan.
 - (vi) "Licensee" means a person who has been granted a licence & includes deemed licensee & persons exempted from license under Section 14 of the Act.
- (2) Words and expressions occurring in these regulations and not defined herein above, shall bear the same meaning assigned to them in the Act.

3. Fee on applications or petitions

- 1) Fees payable with every petition shall be as specified in the Schedule to these regulations.
- 2) All fees shall be payable at Jaipur by means of a crossed demand draft/pay order/postal order drawn in favour of Secretary, Rajasthan Electricity Regulatory Commission.
- 3) The Commission shall issue a receipt for the fee paid.
- 4) The fees received by the Commission under these regulations shall be deposited in a bank account to be maintained by the Commission at such bank and in such branches as the Commission may direct from time to time.

4. Repeal

The Rajasthan Electricity Regulatory Commission (Fee for Petitions) Regulations 2000, as amended to date, shall stand repealed from the date of coming into force of these regulations.

No. RERC/Secy./Reg.72.- in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 86 (g) & 181 of the Electricity Act, 2003 Rajasthan electricity Regulatory Commission hereby makes the following regulations, namely:-

1. Short Title and Commencement :

These regulations will be called the **“Rajasthan electricity regulatory Commission (Fees for Petitions) Regulation, 2005 (4th Amendment)”** and will come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Amendment:

1. The following new items shall be added in the Schedule of fee Structure:

The following new provisions are added at the end of the Schedule of Fee Structure:

Note:

- (1) The Annual licence fee shall be payable every year in advance by 31st March of the current financial year. However, for any delay in remitting annual licence fee, interest at the bank rate plus 2% thereon, shall be charged.
- (2) For Multiyear or Annual ARR/Tariff petitions, the fee corresponding to ARR of the ensuing year only shall, be payable.
- (3) In case of a *suo motto* petition for determination of ARR/Tariff/Wheeling Charges/ Surcharge, the fee specified as above, with surcharge thereon up to a max. of 50%, shall be payable.

Rajasthan Electricity Regulatory Commission (Fee for Petitions) (5th Amendment) Regulations, 2009

1 Short title and commencement

- (1) These Regulations may be called the Rajasthan Electricity Regulatory Commission **(Fee for Petitions) (5th Amendment) Regulations, 2009.**
- (2) These Regulations shall come into force from 30th March, 2009.

2. Amendment

1. The items appearing against existing serial number 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9A, 16,17, 21 in the schedule to the RERC(Fee for petition) Regulations, 2005 and Note (3) below thereof shall be omitted.
2. The following proviso shall be inserted in sub regulation (1)of regulation (3), namely:-
"Provided that, the licensee who has paid Annual Licence Fee in advance shall not be required to pay the fee for petition for determination of ARR/Tariff /Truing up filed during that year."
3. The following proviso shall be inserted in sub regulation (2)of regulation (3), namely:-
"Provided that the fee upto Rs. 20,000/- may be accepted in cash also."
4. The new sub regulation (5) shall be inserted below sub regulation (4)of regulation (3) , namely:-
"(5).The Commission may, if it consider fit, refund/adjust full or part of the fee payable under these regulations by order recording reasons thereof."
