

Pensioners Medical Concessions Fund 1991 (Updated upto 31.03.2008)

Note :- This Scheme was notified by order No. RSEB /F&R/f3 (11) /D.105 dated 24-09-91. accordingly deduction to be made from salary for the moth of sept. 91 payable in the month of Oct 1991 and medical concessions to be admissible with effect from 01-03-92.

Note :- The term 'Board' at the time of notification of the came meant 'Rajasthan state Electrictricith Board' or in short 'RSEB'. With the reorganization of power sector on 19-07-2000, Rajasthan state Electrictricith Board'(RSEB) has been reconfigured into five independent companies namely the Rajasthan Rajya Vidyut Utpadan Nigam Limited Rajasthan Rajya Vidyut Prasaran Nigam Limited Jaipur vidyut vitran nigam Limited, Ajmer vidyut vitran Nigam Limited and Jodhpur vidyut vitran Nigam Limited .All registered under the companies Act 1956 The term 'Board encompassed 'erstwhile Rajasthan State Electricity Board and its successor entities .Viz aforesaid five Companies .'Each of these entities is referred as Nigam .

The Board in its 411th meeting held on 3rd September, 1991 has decided to frame the following scheme for providing medical concessions to the employees of the Board including the employees of erstwhile E&M Department* and also the employees of erstwhile Maharana Bhopal Electricity Supply Co. absorbed in RSEB and who were/are contributing their P.F. Contribution to Maharana Bhopal CPF Trust, who have retired or will retire from the services of the Board, namely:-

Rajasthan State Electricity Board Pensioners Medical Concessions Scheme, 1991.

1. The scheme shall be called "**Rajasthan State Electricity Board Pensioners Medical Concessions Scheme, 1991.**"
2. Definitions: In this scheme, terms used shall have the meaning hereinafter explained:-
 - (i) "**Scheme**" means Rajasthan State Electricity Board Pensioners Medical Concessions Scheme, 1991.
 - ii) "**Pensioners**" means a retired Board's employee who is granted pension under Rajasthan Service Rules being an employee of erstwhile Electrical & Mechanical Deptt. or under RSEB Pension Regulation, 1988 or is retired on the RSEB Employees Contributory Provident Fund Scheme.

** "**Exception**" The word retired Board's employee shall not include those Board's employees who have retired/ will retire from Board's Service consequent upon their absorption in State Public Sector undertakings/Autonomous Bodies/Board's/other statutory Bodies etc.

- iii) "**Authorised Medical Attendant**" means:
 - (a) A Medical Officer or Rajasthan Medical Department on duty in a Government Hospital or Dispensary and
 - (b) A Medical Officer on duty in a non-Government Medical Institution recognised as a Government Hospital under Rajasthan Civil Services Medical Attendance Rules.
 - (c) A Medical Officer on duty in Medical Institution recognised by the RSEB.
- iv) "**Government Hospital**" means a medical Hospital/Dispensary or Institutions maintained by the Government for the purpose of allopathic treatment and also includes a dispensary or a hospital within the State or with which arrangements have been made by the Government for the treatment of Government Servants and other recognised/approved by the Board.

Note:- List of hospitals and dispensaries with which arrangements have been made by the Government for treatment of Government Servants is given in Appendix except an employee appointed on or after 1.1.04.

- (v) **"Family"** means pensioner's wife (not more than one)/husband if wholly dependent upon the pensioner. Wife/Husband will be regarded as wholly dependent upon the pensioner. if she/ he normally resides with the Pensioner. Incase pensioner was having son or un-married daughter suffering from any dis-order or disability of mind or physically crippled or disabled so as to render him/her unable to earn a living will be regarded as member or family for the purpose of Medical facility available in the scheme.
 - vi) **"Trust"** means trust constituted for administration of this scheme.
 - vii) **" Authorised Shops"** means shops recognised under this scheme for the purpose of supplying medicines to the pensioners on cash payment and issuing cash memo on the basis of the prescription of authorised medical attendant.
 - viii) **"Head of Office/Department"** means authority declared as such by the Board.
 - ix) **"Fund"** means" Rajasthan State Electricity Board Pensioners Medical Concessions Fund"
- 3) Free Medical Attendance and Treatment
- (i) Medical Attendance and treatment in a Government Hospital/ Sanitarium/Institute as Indoor and Outdoor patient shall be provided to Board', pensioner and his family as per details given below.
 - (ii) A Board's/Nigam employee except an employee appointed on or after 1.1.04 who is retired from service on pension or Contributory Provident Fund benefits shall be entitled to the following concessions under the Scheme:-
 - (a) Reimbursement of the charges paid for the accommodation in Government Hospital of the category to which the employee was entitled immediately before retirement.
 - (b) Medical attendance in a Government Hospital/Dispensary Sanitarium etc. shall be reimbursable by the Board.
 - (c) All Medical, Surgical and Dental facilities available in the Government Hospital/Dispensary etc. in which the pensioner is treated including employment of pathological, bacteriological, radiological or any other methods as may be considered necessary and advised by the authorised medical attendant, shall be reimbursable by the Board.

*** "CLARIFICATION"**

Reimbursement of the charges paid for various pathological, bacteriological, radiological tests, X-Ray etc. shall be regulated as under: -

- (i) For the tests got done in the Government hospital, actual charges paid shall be reimbursable.
- (ii) In case of non-availability of facility at a particular time, if the tests got done from a private agency after obtaining NAC from the Govt. hospital, the reimbursement in such case shall be admissible to the extent it would have been admissible if the tests got done in the govt. hospital.
- (iii) In case the facility is not available at all and the test got done from a private agency after obtaining NAC from the Government hospital, 60% of the charges paid for such test shall be reimbursable.
 - (d) Reimbursement of the charges paid, if any, for ordinary nursing facilities.
 - (e) Supply of medicines free of charges to the extent, it is ordinarily supplied to other patients when they are treated as Indoor and outdoor patient.
 - (f) Supply of allopathic medicines, vaccines, sera or other therapeutic substances not ordinarily available in Government Hospital free of charge.

****CLARIFICATION**

The Scale of reimbursement of the cost of medicines to the pensioners shall be regulated as under: -

- (i) Reimbursement of the cost of medicines purchased from the authorised shops be allowed upto Rs. **6000/-** only in a financial year to each pensioner provided that this cost ceiling shall not be applicable to these Pensioners who have attained the age of 75 years or above if they furnish documentary proof of age. Provided further that in case of pensioners is suffering from chronic disease like Cancer, T.B., J Heart disease and insulin dependant diabetes, the cost ceiling shall be Rs. 10,000/- in a financial year.
- (ii) Jurisdiction Level Committee as constituted for the purpose. may relax this general limit of Rs. **6000/-** per annum by another Rs. **19000/-** per annum in case of each pensioner. The Jurisdiction Level Committee be comprised of the following.

Note:- The above Committee while relaxing the limit of Rs. 5000/- per annum and above may obtain second medical opinion after scrutiny of the cases where felt necessary.

(iii) Cases of pensioners requiring medicines costing more than Rs. 25000/- in a year be recommended by the Jurisdiction Level Committee to the Sub-Committee of the Company comprising of the following: -

Note: Consultation with P.M.H.O./C.M. & H.O. of the Govt. Hospital/ Dispensary may be done if felt necessary by the above Committee.

(g) In case any of the above facilities are not provided by the Government Hospitals free of charge, then on prescription by the authorised Medical Attendant, the same can be availed on cash payment and such actual charges will be reimbursed to Board's pensioners separately after verification of the cash memos by the authorised medical attendant provided the bills in prescribed Proforma are submitted within the period prescribed in General Medical Attendance Rules.

The reimbursement of cost of only those medicines will be allowed which have been prescribed by the Medical Attendant and have not been incorporated in the negative list of such medicines as issued by the Director of Medical & Health Services from time to time.

*(h) The cost of intra-ocular lenses shall be reimbursed @ 80% of the actual cost of the intra-ocular lenses or Rs. 6000/- whichever is less, to the pensioners, provided that it is certified by the Head of Eye Department of the Government Hospital that free lenses are not available in the hospital and implantation of the same is essential in the cataract Eye operation of the pensioners.

*(iii) Fixed medical allowance to the pensioner/family pensioner drawing pension in a State other than the State of Rajasthan.

(1) In case where a pensioner/family pensioner is drawing his/her pension in a State other than the State of Rajasthan a fixed Medical Allowance @ Rs. 100/- per month shall be payable to him/her provided that he/she becomes member of the Scheme for whole life as per para 10 (v) of the Scheme and he/she is not availing the medical facility available under the Scheme.

(Note: The pensioners of erstwhile E&M Department and those retired from RSEB/Companies under the CPF Scheme are also covered under the definition of pensioners for the purpose of fixed medical allowance. Clarified vide order No. 1063 dated 26.09.06 (F&R 336)

(2) The Pensioner/family pensioner referred to in sub-para (1) shall submit an application in the form appended as appendix-"a" along with the amount of Membership fee and his/her life certificate duly verified by the Gazetted Officer to the C.A.O. (P&F), RVPN, Jaipur through concerned Pension Disbursing Authority.

(3) The amount of fixed Medical Allowance shall be disbursed by the Pension Disbursing Authority to the pensioner/family pensioner in every three months along with the pension, i.e. Medical allowance for the month of

(a) January, February & March along with the pension of March payable in the month of April.

(b) April, May & June along with the pension of June payable in the month of July.

(a) July, August & September along with the pension of September payable in the month of October.

(a) October, November & December along with the pension of December payable in the month of January.

The Pension Disbursing Authority shall maintain a separate register of payments of fixed Medical Allowance in the Pensioner(s)/Family Pensioner(s) referred in sub-para (i).

(4) Every Pensioner/Family Pensioner shall furnish his/her life certificate once in a calendar year to the Pension Disbursing Authority. The release of the amount of fixed Medical Allowance for the month of January and onward, shall be made on receipt of the above certificate.

* 3(A): Treatment of a disease for which treatment is not available in the Govt. hospitals of the State:

1. A pensioner and the member of his family as defined in sub-Para (v) of Para 2 of the scheme suffering from a disease for which treatment is not available in any Government Hospital in the State shall be entitled to financial assistance under the scheme @ 80% of hospital expenditure or Rs. 1.20 Lacs whichever is less, in case treatment is taken in a Hospital/Institution outside the State recognized by the State Government provided that it is certified by the Principal of a Medical College/ Director of Medical & Health Services on the basis of the opinion of the Medical Board constituted by the principal for the purpose to the effect that the treatment of a particular disease from which the patient is suffering is not available in any Government Hospital in a State and it is considered absolutely essential for the recovery of the patient to have treatment at a Hospital outside the State.
2. The facility of treatment in the type of case mentioned in sub-para (1) can be had at any of the Hospitals/ Institutions mentioned in App. II of the Rajasthan Civil Services (Medical Attendance) Rules- 1970.
3. For the purpose of grant of Financial Assistance the original receipts and vouchers issued by such hospitals/ Institution and vouchers of medicines etc. and essentiality certificate (PMCF- 4) shall be countersigned by the Hospital authorities where treatment is taken as well as by the Authorised Medical Attendant of the government Hospital on whose advise the matter of treatment outside the State was considered by the Principal of a Medical College & treatment undertaken outside the State.
4. The pensioners getting treatment in the recognized Hospital approved by the State Government outside the State shall be required to submit his Medical claim after obtaining treatment in accordance with the provision of the scheme to the circle Accounts Officer/ or other such officer who arranges payment of his pension alongwith the following papers enabling the concerned authority for getting the financial assistance admissible under the scheme sanctioned by the C.E./Addl. Secretary(Admn.).
 - i) Attested Photostat copy of the Identity Card (Form PMCF-2) containing joint photo/single photo, as the case may be, and the entry of identity card for that year in which facility is availed.
 - (ii) Essentiality Certificate (PMCF-4) with vouchers duly countersigned by the authorities mentioned in sub-para 3 of para 3 (A) of the scheme,
 - (iii) Attested Photostat copy of the admission/discharge card containing the details of admission, operation & discharge from the Hospital.

- (iv) Original copy of the recommendation made by the Principal of Medical College/Director, Medical & Health services along with opinion tendered by the Medical Board constituted for the purpose.

***Note:-" Notwithstanding anything contained in para 3(A) and (D) of the Scheme in the cases where pensioner or the member of his family as defined in sub para (v) of para 2 of the scheme who is referred for treatment in a hospital/Institution outside the State recognized by the State Government due to lack of facility in a Govt. Hospital in Rajasthan, the pensioner or the member of his family, as the case may be, can take treatment in any private hospital in Rajasthan where such facility exists, if he so wishes. The reimbursement of medical attendance and treatment in such cases shall be admissible to the extent it would have been admissible under the provisions of para 3(A) or 3(D) of the scheme for treatment outside the State applicable from time to time.

*3(B) A Pensioners and the member of his family as defined in sub-para (v) of para 2 of the Scheme shall also be entitled for the grant of financial assistance at the same rate and conditions as indicated in para 3(A) of the scheme except that the constitution of the Medical Board and sanction of the Principal of Medical College/ Director of Medical Health shall not be necessary in respect of specialized treatment like open heart surgery and valve replacement taken in a Govt. Hospital within the State of Rajasthan.

** i) ~~A pensioner and the Members of his family as defined in sub para (5) of para 2 of the scheme shall be entitled for grant of financial assistance in respect of specialized treatments of By pass surgery, open heart surgery, valve replacement, implantation of pace maker and angioplasty/ Balloon plasty taken in a Govt. hospital within the State of Rajasthan, on the scales and conditions as applicable to the State Govt. employees/pensioners.~~

(ii) A pensioner and the Members of his family as defined in sub-para (5) of para (2) of the scheme shall be entitled for grant of financial assistance in respect of specialized treatments of implantation of pace-maker and Angioplasty/ Balloonplasty taken in a Govt. hospital within the State of Rajasthan, as under: -

(a) **Pacemaker**

Actual cost of Pacemaker subject to the maximum of Rs. 60,000/-.

(b) **Angioplasty/Balloonplasty**

Actual expenditure incurred subject to the maximum of Rs. 35,000/-.

(c) **For Stent/Stents**

Actual expenditure incurred subject to **80%** of maximum of Rs. 75,000/- .i.e. **Rs. 60,000**

** iii) The procedure for getting Financial assistance for specialized treatment shall be same as provided in para 3(A) of the scheme except that the constitution of Medical Board and the sanction of the Principal, Medical College/Director, Medical & Health Service shall not be necessary.

* 3(C) A Pensioners and the member of his family as define in sub-para (v) of para - 2 of the Scheme requiring implantation or Pacemaker may he granted financial assistance under the Scheme. 80% of the cost of Pacemaker including its accessories of Rs. 28,000/- (Twenty Eight thousand) only, whichever is less, in case Pacemaker is implanted in any Govt. Hospital in Rajasthan. The constitution of the Medical Board and the sanction of the Principal of Medical College/Director of Medical Health shall not be necessary. Other formalities required for claiming this financial assistance shall be as stated at para 3(A) of the Scheme.

(a) In case it is recommended by the Medical Board that by-pass surgery for heart is indicated, the pensioner can get himself operated in any of the hospitals recognised by the Government outside the State for this purpose. Such pensioner may be allowed 80% of hospital expenses limited to Rs. 48,000/- being 80%of General Ward charges of All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi.

b) In case a pensioner undergoes by-pass surgery for heart (Cardio Thoracic surgery) in any recognised hospital outside the State in emergent circumstances without any recommendation of the Medical Board, he may be allowed 80% of hospital expenses limited to Rs.48,000/- i.e. 80% of General Ward charges of AIIMS, New Delhi provided that he submits a Certificate from a Cardiologist who holds a degree of D.M. in Cardiology or MCH in Cardio Thoracic Surgery stating that pensioner's condition was such that immediate treatment was essential. (Complete Para 3D substituted vide order No. 447 dated 17.06.05 (F&R No. 276)

c) In case a pensioner takes treatment of Angioplasty/Balloonplasty and stent(s) in recognized hospitals outside the State, he/she may be allowed financial assistance as under: -

(i) **Angioplasty/Balloonplasty**

Actual amount of expenditure incurred subject to the maximum of Rs. 35,000/-.

(ii) **For Stent/Stents**

Actual cost of Stent/Stent(s) subject to the maximum of Rs. 60,000/- (80% of Rs. 75,000/-). Sub-para 3D (c) inserted vide order No. 447 dated 17.06.05 (F&R No. 276)

- *3 (E) Henceforth, the reimbursement of the expenses incurred by the pensioner on taking treatment of himself/herself or members of his/her family, of such disease treatment of which is available in the government hospital within the state but the pensioners opts to take treatment in a hospital/Institution (other than a government hospital) within/outside the state.

Reimbursement of such expenditure shall be subject to the following conditions: -

1. The amount to be reimbursed shall be restricted to the estimated amount indicated in the certificate to be issued by the Principal of Government Medical College/Director, Medical & Health Services, to expenditure for similar treatment taken at a Govt. Hospital.
2. In cases the treatment is not taken in a Govt. Hospital in the State at patient choice, the reimbursable amount would be equivalent to expenditure admissible in the Govt. Hospital. The hospital at which treatment may be taken and the disease identified for such treatment shall be following:

1. Heart-Bypass Surgery/Angioplasty/Angiography/ Valve replacement & Heart related operations.
2. Cancer Treatment.
3. Kidney Transplant & Dialysis.

1[RVUN's decision : Reimbursement of expenses for treatment taken in private hospitals : Procedure approved for reimbursement of expenses of treatment taken in various authorized 2[private] hospitals shall be as follows:

1. Re-imbusement for tests /investigation be allowed on the scale of rates for similar tests a prescribed by Government of Rajasthan /Rajasthan Medical Relief Society.

3[Clarification : MRI and CT Scan tests /investigation done by M/s Vardhman Scanners and imagers private limited shall be treated as via Rajasthan medicare Society and shall be reimbursable at the prescribed rate. There will no necessity of recommendations of Medical Board for MRI test. MRI test for outdoor patients and accident cases can be had in the consultations with duty doctor of Govt. Hospital which can be canfirmed later by unit head /head of department and for outdoor

patients it will be in consultations with unit head /head of department of Govt. Hospital provided that in case of places other than Jaipur such tests had after obtaining NAC from duty doctor /unit head /head of department above shall be reimbursable at actual cost subject to ceiling of prescribed rates by medical relief society in SMS Hospital ,Jaipur]

2. Ward /Accommodation charges : In case of indoor patient, ward/ Accommodation Charges be allowed as per Rajasthan Civil Services (Medical Attendance) Rules.
3. Cost of medicines & other equipments: cost of medicines in respect of reimbursable medicines be allowed as per Rajasthan Civil Services (Medical Attendance) Rules.]

[3(E)(i) The following private Hospitals are recognized for the pensioners of erstwhile RSEB /Power sector Entities ,for taking all kinds of treatment & reimbursement of medical expense. 5. RECOVERY OF SUBSCRIPTION FROM MONTHLY PAY BILLS: -

Recovery of the subscription at the rates mentioned above shall be made from the monthly pay bills by each Head of Office/Deptt. for credit to the Rajasthan

State Electricity Board Pensioners Medical Concession Fund. The details of the recoveries made from the employees of the Board shall be indicated in the form RSEB PMCF-1 which shall accompany every monthly pay bill.

6. ACCOUNT OF FUND IN THE BANK: -

Current Accounts titled "Rajasthan State Electricity Board Pensioners Medical Concession Fund" shall be opened in authorised Banks at Headquarter by each accounting unit to which the amount recovered from Board's employees by way of deductions from their respective bills and such deductions shall be deposited by the Circle Accounts Officers. Cheque for payment out of the fund shall be signed jointly by Superintending Engineers and the Circle Accounts Officer or officers specially authorised by Chief Administrator of the fund in consultation with Chief Accounts Officer (P&F).

7. ADMINISTRATION OF FUND: -

- (i) The fund and property relating to RSEB Pensioners Medical Concessions Fund shall vest in the Trust.
- (ii) The Administration of the fund shall vest in a Board of Trustees from amongst the officers of the Board and shall have its Head quarter at Jaipur and the Chairman RSEB will be the Chairman of the Board of Trustees. The other Trustees of the fund shall comprise the following: -
 - (a) Chairman
 - (b) Member (F&A)
 - (c) Secretary
 - (d) Chief Engineer (PPM)
 - (e) One retired Chief Engineer (Pensioner) to be nominated by the Chairman.
 - (f) One retired employee (Pensioner) of RSEB to be nominated by the Chairman.
 - (g) Chief Accounts Officer (P&F) – Member-Secretary.

Superintending Engineer and Accounts Officer shall function as Administrator and Secretary of the fund in the respective circles. They shall jointly sign cheques for reimbursement. Separate cash book would be maintained. All receipts and expenditure relating to the said fund shall be classified under "RSEB Pensioners Medical Concessions Fund."

- (iii) The cost of administration of the Trust fund shall be borne by the Board except allowance to the Board employees doing part time service for the fund.
- (iv) Accommodation, furniture, light and water charges, Stationary charges and expenditure on pay and allowances to the staff shall be met out of the fund but the Board would reimburse the

expenditure to the trust to the extent of rs. 50000/- or as may be revised by the Board.

8. INTEREST ON THE FUND: -

Central Account of the fund be maintained by the CAO (P&F). Monthly saving of the fund after retaining amount equal to average monthly expenditure on Medical reimbursement to the pensioners shall be transferred by the Circle Accounts Officers to the Central Account which shall be invested in Central Government saving scheme, U.T.I., L.I.C. Scheme etc. as directed by the Board of Trustees.

9. RECOGNISITON OF AUTHORISED SHOP: -

- (i) All Co-operative Medical Stores organized and run by Rajasthan Sahakari Upbhokta Sangh shall be authorised shops for purchase of medicines by the pensioners on the basis of prescription by the authorised medical attendant of State Hospital/Dispensary under this scheme.

*Provided that if the Medicines is/are not available in the Co-operative Medical Stores organized and run by Rajasthan Sahakari Sangh, such Medicines may be purchased from other Medical shops after obtaining NAC from Co-operative Medical Stores.

- (ii) At the places where there is no co-operative medical stores referred to above, the concerned Superintending Engineer (Administrator) shall recognise certain licensed Medical Stores/Shops for purchase of medicines by the pensioners under this scheme.

Places where there are no Co-operative Medical Stores and the licensed medical stores/shops have been recognised by the collector of the Distt.for State pensioners, the same should be treated as recognised medical stores/shops for reimbursement of medical claim in respect of Board's pensioner under the above provisions and the Superintending Engineer concerned should recognise such shops (As per order No. RSEB/F&R/F.3 (ii)/D.8 dated 14.3.96).

10. Procedure for obtaining medicines from authorised medical shop by the pensioners.

- (i) Every Pensioner will have as identity card (Form PMCF-2) which shall contain his particulars and joint photo of himself and his wife. The photo on the identity card will be attested by the Head of Office in which he was last working or by Dy. Chief Accounts Officer (P&F), RSEB, Jaipur.
- (ii) The authorised Medical attendant shall after identification of the pensioner on the basis of identity card, prescribe medicines on outdoor patient ticket. The outdoor patient ticket shall bear signature of the authorised medical attendant with his office seal.

- (iii) The pensioner shall present claims of reimbursement of medical expenses in respect of the member of his family including himself/herself in the prescribed forms (PMCF-4 & 5) in the office from which he is getting his pension or has been registered under the scheme for arranging the payment.

Provided that the claims of an amount upto the limit prescribed for in service employees, from time to time, for reimbursement on the basis of prescription of Authorised Medical Attendant shall be presented by the pensioner only in prescribed proforma PMCF-5.

- (iv) It will be obligatory for every pensioner drawing pension within the State to get the medical card (Form No. PMCF-2) renewed every year on payment of annual renewal fee and those who are drawing pension outside State shall be required to make one time payment for whole life on the following scales: -

- ** (v) It will be obligatory for every pensioner either to get the identity card (Form PMCF-2) renewed every year or at the time on the payment of fees at the rates given in para (iv) above. The Accounts Officer concerned shall make an entry of this effect in office record that the pensioner has deposited one time renewal fee of the identity card and shall sign below the renewal order. The seal of one time renewal fee shall be affixed on the new identity cards which may be issued from time to time. The one time renewal fee which shall be in addition to the price of the card shall be credited to the fund. The Accounts Officer concerned shall maintain proper account of one time renewal fee received.

Note: In the 8th meeting of the Board of Trustees of PMCF held on 17.02.2007, it has been decided that the renewal fee for every financial year is to be deposited by the

pensioners by 31th May. In such an event the pensioner will get reimbursement for full financial year. In case the renewal fee is deposited after 15th May, then the pensioner(s) will get the reimbursement of such admissible treatments only from the date the renewal fee is deposited and not for the period prior to that date. #10 (A) (i): -The pensioner/family pensioner can avail medical facility under allopathic, Ayurvedic and Homeopathic system of treatment under the scheme and no option would be necessary.

#10 (A) (ii): -The terms and conditions for reimbursement of expenses incurred by a pensioner of the company on account of Medical Attendance and treatment under Ayurved or Homeopathy shall be as per terms and conditions applicable from time to time, for serving employees of the Company.

11. THE FUNCTION OF THE CIRCLE/OTHER ACCOUNTS OFFICER UNDER THE SCHEME.

(i) The Circle/other Accounts Officers delegated with the bill passing powers will ensure that the deductions at the prescribed rates of the subscriptions are made from the monthly pay bills of each Board's employee and recovery schedule in support of the deductions so made is attached to each monthly pay bill.

(ii) The total monthly deductions made from the bills of the employees shall be deposited in the bank by the concerned Administrator/Circle Accounts Officer immediately after entering into cash book maintained separately for the aforesaid fund.

(iii) Funds required for reimbursement shall be drawn by cheque(s) as per necessity, preferably not more than once in a week.

(iv) The Circle Accounts Officer shall send a monthly statement showing total debits/credits and balance in the fund at the close of each month to the Chief Accounts Officer (P&F) by 7th of the following month in the prescribed proforma (PMCF-6). A list of cheques issued for payment shall also be sent every month to the chief Accounts Officer (P&F) in the prescribed proforma (PMCF-7) for apprising the Board of Trustees about monthly expenditure/savings, progressively total/accumulation of fund and its investment after retaining the amount equal to average monthly expenditure on medical reimbursement to the pensioners.

- (v) The cheque books shall be entered into a separate register and stocked at the Concerned Head quarters of the respective authorised officers.
- (vi) The respective Accounts Officer, Asstt. Accounts Officer (Pension) and Dy. Controller of Accounts (P&F) will utilise the services of cashier or any of the junior accountant working under him for doing account work of the fund and a part time allowance of Rs. 100/- per month shall be paid to him out of fund.
- (vii) Bill for a reimbursement shall be preferred by the Pensioners once in a month to the Circle Accounts Officer or other such officer who arranges payment of his pension. The Circle Accounts Officer or such officer shall keep individual account of medical reimbursement in the separate register. He shall make the payment to the claimant by drawing cheque duly signed by the Circle Superintending Engineer (in absence of Superintending Engineer / by any officer authorised by the Board of Trustees) and himself by operating the fund account in bank. Account of expenditure incurred shall be sent by such officer to the Chief Accounts Officer (P&F), RSEB, Jaipur.
- (viii) The cash memo and essentiality certificate will be verified by the Authorised Medical Attendant of the State Hospital/State Dispensary *except in case of claims of an amount upto a limit prescribed from time to time for in service employees for reimbursement on the basis of prescription of authorised Medical Attendant. However, such Authorised Medical Attendant shall bear OPD Registration number and date of State Hospital/State Dispensary where treatment is undertaken and authorised Medical Attendant shall super-scribe his signature on such prescription under his office seal.

- 12. The Secretary, RSEB shall function as Chief Administrator so as to ensure proper implementation of the scheme and to make any changes in the procedure on the recommendations of the Chief Accounts Officer (P&F).
- 13. The Board of Trustees shall send annual report on the working of the scheme.
- 14. The medical concession to the pensioner mentioned in para 3 of this scheme shall be admissible w.e.f. 1st March, 1992.
- 15. The Board of Trustees may grant to the pensioner any concession relating to medical treatment or attendance which is not provided in this scheme in individual cases of extreme hardship on merits.
- 16. ABUSE-USES OF CONCESSIONS: -

- (i) In cases it is found that a pensioner has abused/misused any concession allowed under the scheme, he shall be permanently debarred from availing the concessions under this scheme.
- (ii) The respective Chief Engineer/Superintending Engineer/Chief Accounts Officer (P&F) who are administrators of the Trust Fund pertaining to the offices falling under their jurisdiction, if satisfied that pensioner has abused/misused the concession(s) under the scheme, shall be competent to pass final order under clause (i) above and no appeal shall lie against such order.

17. QUORUM AND MEETING: -

- (i) Meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be held at least half yearly with at least five Members of the trust being present.
- (ii) Every issue shall be decided by majority votes of the Trustees present and voting. In the event of equality of votes the Chairman shall have a casting vote.

Provided that the Chairman may, if he thinks fit direct that any question shall be decided by Circulation.

- (iii) The minutes of the meeting of the Board of Trustees showing interalia the names of the Trustees present be recorded in a minute book as a permanent record.
