

Safety guidelines for delivery of auctioned material

At the time of delivery of auctioned material/ items precautions must be taken to safeguard the personnel/ property of Nigam. The personnel of the purchaser to whom delivery of material is made must ensure following:

1. As far as possible, material should not be dismantled at site and taken out of premises of RVPN safely. Delivery of material be made only during the normal working hours and in no case on any holiday and in night so that sufficient staff is available to handle any hazard.
2. Should dismantling is necessary for removal of material, only authorized persons with identity proof recorded be allowed in the RVPN premises.
3. Dismantling of material be done by skilled personnel in supervision of site in charge of RVPN.
4. The personnel of the purchaser shall at all times follow safety instructions of the site in charge of the RVPN. The personnel of the purchaser shall ensure all safety norms and regulations in this regard.
5. The purchaser shall ensure dismantling of the material in safe environment. Material to be dismantled shall be disconnected from the RVPN system, isolated and properly marked.
6. Though all responsibility for safe removal of material rests with the purchaser, its authorised personnel shall wear safety helmets/ shoes/ gloves etc. and shall have necessary safety equipment/ first aid kit etc.
7. As far as possible no gas cutter shall be used for dismantling/ cutting of equipment to be removed from site. If gas cutter is used, fire buckets/ fire extinguisher/ fire pump shall be installed at site near the equipment being dismantled. All personnel of the purchaser shall be trained to use the safety equipment.
