ORDER**Sub.:- Feeder-wise billing pursuant to implementation of TN-64-Revenue Management System;**

In the meeting of IT working group held on 16.02.2018, it has been decided to carry out feeder wise billing pursuant to implanting the TN-64-Revenue Management System w.e.f. 01.04.2018 in all the circles, except JCC.

In order to ensure smooth implementation of the above decision through the outsourced agency M/S BCITS, following instructions/guidelines are hereby conveyed for compliance by the all concerned:-

1. The mode of billing shall be monthly;
2. The respective AROs shall invariably ensure that all the input data required to be feeded manually for billing is uploaded in the system on day to day basis;
3. Feeder wise soft binders shall be maintained and shall be scheduled for billing from 1st to 10th of the calendar month along with dynamic due dates based upon respective generation/issuance of spot bill. However, the respective AEN in consultation with the ARO shall be competent for deviation in the above billing schedule/programme keeping in view the prevailing ground realities/circumstances;
4. After full implementation and stabilization of the system, the input data shall stand uploaded instantly on virtual basis. However, in the beginning till the system is fully operationalise, the input data uploaded up to the last day of the previous month shall be taken into account for the purpose of the current month billing.
5. The billing of consumers having sanctioned load up to 18.65 K.W. (25 HP) shall only be generated at the spot, while the rest shall continue to be generated and delivered through the base billing mode ;
6. For the billing purposes the billing period shall be worked out dynamically from the date of the last meter reading to the date of current meter reading, following the prevailing tariff provisions.
