Sub:- Disposal of VCRs through Assessment Review Committee.

In compliance to order dated 27.01.2021 (JPR5-1045), regarding disposal of VCRs through Assessment Review Committee at various levels, Following process shall be adopted for registering the cases in Assessment Review Committee:

1. The consumer/non consumer can apply for review of assessment against VCR within 30 days from the date of issue of notice of assessment.
2. The consumer/non-consumer has to deposit 10% or Rs. 5 Lacs whichever less of civil liability amount with full compounding amount before registering case with Assessment Review Committee.
3. If the consumer wants reconnection of supply then he has to deposit 50% of the civil liability amount and full compounding amount before registering the case with Assessment Review Committee.

For disposal of VCRs drawn before 27.01.2021 (JPR5-1045) of consumer/non-consumer, it was directed vide JPR5-1047 that intimation be given to all consumer/non-consumer that they can apply to Assessment Review Committee by 10.03.2021 and thereafter their case will not entertained by any Assessment Review Committees.

You are therefore advised to impart necessary direction to the field officers to dispose the old VCRs so as to settle the old issues and consumer grievances.
