ORDER

Sub: Disposal of pending VCR's upto 30.06.2016

Detailed directions for disposal of pending VCR's were issued vide this office order No. JPR 5-856 dated 01.05.2017 & JPR 5-860 dated 31.05.2017. The issue was discussed in the meeting of Working Group-1 constituted to achieve financial break even in Jaipur Discom in FY 2017-18. During discussions of BEP, it is observed that large Nos. of VCRs consisting of theft/ misuse nature are pending for logical conclusion. Therefore for liquidate such pending VCRs as well as to resolve consumer/ non consumer grievances, an scheme was launched vide JPR5-856 dt. 01.05.2017. In order to make this scheme more simplified and consumer friendly, following revised guidelines are hereby issued.

The officer of O&M and vigilance wing both shall be responsible for assessment of pending VCR's (VCR's upto 30.06.2016), where assessment are not made till date. They will ensure to issue notices upto 16th August, 2017 after making assessment in the enclosed format to the consumer/ non consumer. The Assistant Engineer of the sub-division is authorized to dispose the VCR's by accepting the following amount.

1. If assessment for Civil liabilities plus Compounding charges of pending VCRs is upto Rs.50,000 (fifty thousand), concerned Assistant Engineer (O&M) is authorized to close the VCRs depositing 50% of Civil liabilities plus Compounding charges.

2. If assessment for Civil liabilities plus Compounding charges of pending VCRs is more than Rs.50,000 (fifty thousand), concerned Assistant Engineer(O&M) is authorized to close the VCRs by depositing Rs. 25,000 (twenty five thousand) plus 10% of the amount above Rs. fifty thousand of the Civil liabilities plus Compounding charges.
3. The such cases after closing the VCR shall be reported to APTPS where FIR has been lodged for disposal of FIR.

The scheme shall be effective from 1.08.2017 to 30.11.2017. The cases already decided shall not be re-opened. The sub-divisional officer shall ensure wide publicity of the scheme amongst effected consumers/ non-consumers. The concerned officer will send the periodical information in the enclosed format to Addl. SP (Vig.), Jaipur positively.

This order is issued in suppression to Order No. JPR5-856 dated 01.05.2017 & JPR5-860 dated 31.05.2017.
