ORDER

Sub: Extension of time period of “Amnesty Scheme” introduced vide Order No.JPR5-671 dated 8/11/12.

“Amnesty Scheme” was introduced vide Order No.JPR5-671 dated 8.11.12 for realization of outstanding dues from all categories of consumers disconnected prior to 31.3.12. The scheme was available upto 31.12.2012.

In view of more recovery expected from disconnected consumers, the matter for extension of period of the scheme for two months was placed before the Discoms Co-ordination Forum meeting held on 26.12.12.

The Discoms Co-ordination Forum allowed to extend the scheme up to 28.02.2013 with the following terms & conditions and for the relaxation to ensure more outstanding recovery :-

1. The Amnesty scheme shall not be available to the consumers who have already availed benefit from such schemes in last 3 years.
2. For availing the concession package, the consumer shall require to apply to the concerned Assistant Engineer for all categories of consumers except large industrial category. In case of LIP, they will have to apply to the Accounts Officer(HTB) in the format enclosed at Annexure- 'B'.
3. The outstanding dues should be worked-out after adjusting security deposit if not already adjusted.
4. One time payment to be taken and no instalment is to be allowed.
5. This scheme shall be applicable irrespective of the condition whether disconnected consumer wants reconnection or not.
6. The disconnected agriculture connections shall be reconnected in accordance with the prevailing provisions of Agriculture Policy.
7. The disconnected consumers of all other than A.G. category will be allowed reconnection within the specified period as per TCOS-2004(Amended) after depositing the outstanding amount and for reconnection if any additional line is required to be laid, then the cost of the same shall be borne by the consumer as per prevailing rules of the Nigam.

However, in case of Domestic/Non Domestic consumers up to sanction load 5KW covered under the “Amnesty Scheme” if desires to get his connection reconnected, may be allowed, irrespective of the period of disconnection after

depositing full principle amount, reconnection charges and security amount if adjusted earlier, as per prevailing norms,

8. The outstanding amount due to theft/malpractice charges may also be accepted under this scheme subject to the condition that no relaxation will be allowed in principle amount decided by the Assessing Authority and only LPS/DPS over & above the principle amount shall be waived for recovery of old dues.
9. If case is pending with any Court of Law and consumer desires to deposit principle amount under Amnesty Scheme, the same may be accepted after waiver of DPS/LPS. However, "no dues" will be given to consumer after withdrawal of court case by him.
