

ORDER**Sub. : Shifting of electric lines/poles falling in the alignment of National Highway under Jaipur Discom - Giving credit of Salvage Value to NHAI.**

The issue of giving credit of released/dismantled material in favour of NHAI, on account of shifting of electric lines/poles falling in the alignment of National Highway, was again examined in light of provisions of "Terms & Conditions for Supply of Electricity - 2004" (TCS-04).

After detailed discussions it has been decided to follow the following procedure for giving credit of released/dismantled material in favour of "National Highway Authorities of India", for the cases of shifting of lines/poles :-

NHAI, who are carrying out the work of shifting of lines/poles & again lying along the National Highways, shall continue to deposit the material of redundant lines/poles, sub-stations etc. with the concerned Asstt. Engineer of Jaipur Discom. The field officers of the Discom shall prepare an account of the cost of material deposited with the concerned AEN, at the prevailing rates. Thereafter, credit @ 25% of the estimated amount as above be allowed to the NHAI towards salvage value.

The Terms & Condition at No. 5 of the earlier letter No. 2220 dt. 2.12.05 shall be substituted by the following :-

5. "Material of redundant lines & sub-station shall be deposited with the concerned Asstt. Engineer of Jaipur Discom for which a credit @25% of the estimated cost of the material deposited, at the prevailing rates shall be given to NHAI".
