**ORDER**

**Sub: Exemption in payment of interest charges for large Industrial consumers having outstanding dues of more than Rs. 10 lacs (Rupees Ten Lacs only ) provided the consumer pays the total outstanding dues in one stroke.**

There are 58 large industrial consumers having outstanding dues more than Rs. 10 lacs and lying disconnected (PDC) for a long time. The total dues against these consumers, after adjusting the amount of available security deposit, are Rs. 69.14 crore which is lying un-recovered for the last few years.

The matter was placed before the Board of Directors of Jaipur Discom, in its 159<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 25<sup>th</sup> May, 09 and a scheme for recovery of outstanding dues from large industrial consumers was placed for considerations. After detailed discussions, the BOD's of Jaipur Discom have approved the proposed scheme which is subject to following conditions:-

- I) This scheme will be available to all the large industrial consumers whose connections were disconnected on or prior to 31-3-98.
- II) The consumer would be allowed to deposit the outstanding amount as on date of disconnection, in one stroke.
- III) The interest on principal amount as on date of disconnection will be waived and hence will not be recovered.
- IV) The scheme will be available for three months period from 1.6.09 to 31.8.09.
- V) No reconnection of disconnected connection will be allowed and the purpose of proposed scheme is for settling outstanding dues.
