ORDER

Sub: Incentive Scheme for recovery of dues
From various categories of PDC consumers
(permanently disconnected consumers)
whose connections were disconnected prior
to March'06.

In order to recover the outstanding dues from permanently disconnected consumers (PDC) of the Discom, a lot of efforts have been made in the past but no fruitful results are forthcoming despite the fact that efforts were also made through private firms by allowing incentive @8% of the amount recovered from PDC consumers.

In the above background, a scheme was prepared for recovery of outstanding dues from permanently disconnected consumers of the Discoms and put up before the Distribution Coordination Forum (DCF) for consideration, in its meeting held on 24.6.09. The DCF decided to put up this scheme for approval of the Coordination Committee.

The matter was put up before the Coordination Committee in its 128th meeting held on 30.6.09 and an Incentive Scheme with following salient features of the scheme have been approved:-

- i) This scheme will be available for working/ retired departmental employee(s) of Discom i.e. the working/retired employee(s) of Discom would be beneficiaries under the scheme.
- ii) The Departmental employee(s) may participate in this incentive scheme for recovery of dues of PDC connections by making an entry in the register maintained in O&M Sub Division for the purpose.
- iii) The O&M Sub division would be required to keep one "PDC Recovery Register" in which any employee who is hopeful & helpful for recovery of outstanding dues from a PDC connection shall be required to mention the following details:-
 - (a) Particulars of PDC connections
 - (b) Employee's name and designation.
- iv) The sub division shall give a registration number to the concerned employee in the following manner:-

Suppose there is a consumer in D-I sub division in Jaipur City Circle(JCC). The AEN (D-I) will be given the

identification No. JCC/D-I/17, where 17 is the Sr. No. at which the entry has been made in the PDC Recovery Register of the sub division for recovery of outstanding dues for a particular PDC connection.

- v) One registration No. will remain valid for a period of one month in the first instance. After expiry of one month period, the working/retired employee(s) shall have to get renewed the Registration No. and apprise the AEN of the sub division about the efforts made and progress achieved in the matter of recovery of dues.
- vi) The employee whose efforts will be pivotal in recovery of the outstanding dues would be given an incentive of 8% of the total amount realized from the PDC connections.
- vii) In case the PDC consumer has taken a new connection in some other sub division in that case the whereabouts of the connection of the PDC consumer in the other sub division are to be searched/traced.
- viii) In cases where the outstanding dues are recovered by debiting dues in the account of some other connections in the name of defaulter consumer, in such a case the working/retired employee who has contributed for recovery of the outstanding dues, be allowed an incentive of 7% only. The Ledger keeper of the sub division who had debited the outstanding dues in the current account of the consumer, would be allowed an incentive of 1% of the amount of outstanding dues so recovered.
- ix) The maximum amount of incentive in individual case shall have no ceiling. It will be 8% of the amount realized.
- x) Connections of Central Govt./State Govt./ Local Bodies etc. are not covered under the ambit of proposed scheme.
- xi) The proposed scheme shall remain available for an initial period of (6) six months.

It is also to emphasize that the sub division or the division concerned are expected to render plausible support to the working/retired employee(s) by way of initiating EUDR proceedings in individual connections, if the same is found necessary. In other words, the division or sub division is required to fully co-operate in the matter of recovery of outstanding dues from PDC consumer(s).

The sub division showing exemplary progress in the recovery of dues would also be given suitable cash prizes to be decided at a later stage.

This order shall come into force with immediate effect.
