ORDER

Sub: Procedure for billing of Renewable Energy Generator.

The Clause 90(1) of RERC Tariff Regulation, 2009 prescribes that Energy drawn during start up and backing down up to a maximum of 42 days in a financial year be set off against the energy sale to the distribution licensee within State thereafter, energy drawn be billed at temporary tariff on daily basis. Where sale to distribution licensee is not affected, such drawl be billed on daily basis.

Accordingly, energy drawn upto 42 days in a financial year by renewable energy generator is to be set off against the energy sale to Discoms on regular basis. The energy drawn by a generator beyond 42 days in a financial year is to be billed on temporary tariff.

It has been observed that the accounting of energy drawn for more than 42 days is not being monitored and maintained properly, due to which some time such generator draws energy for more than 42 days and not billed at temporary tariff at any level.

To streamline the billing of renewable energy generators, following procedure is hereby prescribed:


1. Monthly readings along with MRI shall be taken by M&P Wing. The M&P Wing shall prepare an abstract on monthly basis showing total energy export/import (sale/drawn) along with number of days for which the energy has been supplied/drawn by generator. The cumulative number of days for which energy

has been drawn by generator in a financial year, shall also be mentioned. This information be sent to SE(RDPPC), JVVNL, Jaipur for billing purpose.

2. The SE(RDPPC), JVVNL, Jaipur shall prepare bills for energy supply to Discoms after adjusting the energy drawn from Discoms for 42 days. The SE(RDPPC), JVVNL, Jaipur shall be responsible to assess the amount of energy supplied by the Discoms to generator(beyond 42 days) in a financial year at temporary tariff on daily basis. The bills of generator for the energy supplied to the Discoms shall be passed by SE(RDPPC), JVVNL, Jaipur after due adjustment of the bills so assessed at temporary tariff. The units and amount so adjusted shall be intimated to concerned AEN(O&M), Jaipur Discom, by RDPPC through credit advice for accounting of sale of energy and realization through MS-14.
3. In case generator does not supply energy to the Discoms, or not raises the bill, and only draws power from Discoms, then the amount assessed at temporary tariff on daily basis, shall also be intimated to concerned Assistant Engineer(O&M), Jaipur Discom for raising of bill & recovery of the amount as per provisions of TCOS-2004. The units so consumed beyond 42 days and bills raised at temporary tariff by RDPPC shall be taken in the account by Assistant Engineer(O&M), Jaipur Discom through MS-14 on monthly basis. The entry of realization shall be made accordingly.
4. The concerned Assistant Engineer(O&M), Jaipur Discom, after recovering the amount shall intimate the same to SE(RDPPC), JVVNL, Jaipur for cross reference.

The above procedure shall strictly be adhered to and non-compliance will be viewed seriously.
