ORDER


Sub.: Disconnecting connection(s) without issuing seven days notice required under the provisions of Section-24 (1) of the Indian Electricity Act, 1910.

In accordance with the existing provisions, in case a consumer fails to make the payment of energy bills within due date, a notice of clear seven days in writing is required to be given under sub section-1 of Section-24 of the Indian Electricity Act, 1910 before disconnecting the supply. Time to time these instructions were also reiterated.

It has been reported that still in some cases the connections have been disconnected without issuing such notices even where the amount due had also been deposited. This is against the statutory provisions of the Act & leads to avoidable litigations.


It is, therefore, once again reiterated that to avoid legal complications, connections should be disconnected after expiry of a written notice of seven days, except in specific cases where an agreement dispensing with the requirement of notice has been executed.
