ORDER

Sub : Refund of excess cash security deposit to industrial consumers.

In accordance with the existing provisions, the security deposit available with Jaipur Discom is to be reviewed in the beginning of every financial year and short falls, if any is to be recovered only from the tenants/occupants and the consumers who default twice in a financial year in making payment of regular energy bills within the stipulated period. Similarly in accordance with the erstwhile Board's order No. 1426 dt. 2-6-95 (Comml.-68) in case of industrial consumers, if the amount of security deposit after review works-out to be less than the amount available with the erstwhile RSEB/Jaipur Discom, the same is required to be refunded to the consumers through adjustment in monthly energy bills. As per practice the refund of security equivalent to minimum billing for two months/one and a half month/one month period whichever is applicable corresponding to contract demand got reduced by consumer is adjusted in energy bills.

Representation are being received from consumers stating that since their contract demand has been allowed to be reduced, the amount of security deposit should be recalculated by the Nigam on the basis of reduced contract demand and if the amount of security deposit available with Discom is found in excess then the same should be refunded to them.
