## ORDER

Sub: Delegation of Powers for shifting and releasing of PHED connections.


PHED authorities have approached field officers for shifting of existing PHED connections alongwith the existing 11 KV lines and distribution transformer to a new location due to drying of water sources. As per existing provisions, sanctioning authority for release of new connections are also empowered for shifting of existing connections in the same locality subject to technical feasibility for agriculture connection.

Similarly, for release of new PHED connections upto 11 KV, AEn (O&M) of the Nigam have been empowered to accord technical and financial sanctions irrespective of the amount of estimate. Yet clarification are being asked by Field officers as to whether the cost of line and 11 KV/0.4 Sub-stations and transformer are chargeable to PHED or credit of line material, Sub-station structure and distribution transformer is to be given to PHED.

For speedy disposal of shifting cases of PHED connections and for uniformity of charges, the issue was discussed in the Sr. Officers Conference of Jaipur Discom held on 22-4-03 wherein it was decided that for shifting of PHED lines same charges be levied as are being charged for agriculture connections and for which the Executive Engineers (O&M) are empowered to issue such sanctions.

It is further to clarify that the sanction for the express feeder for existing PHED connection should be issued as per delegation of power i.e. according to cost of works. For sanction of new PHED connections, Assistant Engineer (O&M) of Nigam have been delegated full powers. As regards the charging of the cost of terminal equipments required for express feeder at 33 KV S/S, the cost be borne by the Nigam, if metering is provided at 33 KV S/s in accordance of erstwhile RSEB circular No. 4005 dt. 4.12.1975, otherwise the cost of terminal equipment is to be borne by the PHED.
