ORDER

Sub : Dispensing with the facility of depositing
50% amount of transformer back-up charges in
12 equal monthly instalments.

In accordance with the existing provisions, a sum of Rs. 250 per KVA/KW of sanctioned contract demand/ connected load is being recovered against the transformer back-up charges. Consumers were also allowed the facility of depositing 50% of the recoverable amount i.e. Rs. 125 per KVA/KW before release of connection and the balance 50% amount was allowed to be is recovered in 12 equal monthly instalment after release of connection. This amount of transformer back-up charges was refundable through adjustment in the monthly energy bills which was to commence after the consumer had deposited entire amount @ Rs. 250 per KVA/KW of back-up transformer charges (total transformer back-up).

The erstwhile Board however, reviewed this position and revised instructions were issued vide order No. Comml.-524 dt. 10-7-2000. According to these instructions the practice of refund of transformer back-up charges in energy bills was dispensed with.

The whole matter was put-up for considerations considered in the Coordination Committee in its 60th meeting held on 7-8-03. In view of the precarious financial position of Discom, it has been decided that henceforth the facility of depositing 50% amount of transformer back-up charges in 12 equal monthly instalment shall stand withdrawn.

It is, therefore, enjoined upon all concerned that henceforth total amount of transformer back-up charges @ 250 Per KVA/KW to be recovered in one stroke from prospective consumers at the time of release of connection/extension in contract demand or connected load.
