ORDER

Sub : Concession package to be allowed for
revival of industries disconnected during
1-3-98 to 31-3-2000.

The erstwhile Board had announced a concession package for the purpose of revival of industries whose connections were lying disconnected prior to/ or on 28-2-1998 by way of charging inter-est @ 12% instead of 18% on the outstanding dues. The amount of interest so calculated was also prescribed to be limited to the principal amount of outstanding dues at the time of disconnection and the balance of amount of interest was allowed to be waived of. It was also prescribed therein that such industries shall pay total outstanding dues as existing on the date of disconnection with interest in one stroke only.

This concessional package was prescribed vide order No. (Comml-478) in the first instance and was subsequently extended on the same terms & conditions till further orders. Presently these concessions are in force.

The matter regarding grant of above mentioned facilities to those industries which were disconnected during 1-3-98 to 31-3-2000 was considered in the meeting of Co-ordination Committee held on 27-3-2001 and it was decided that industrial connections which were disconnected during the intervening period i.e. 1-3-98 to 31-3-2000 should also be allowed the benefit of concessional package issued by the erstwhile Board vide Comml-478 dated 18-3-2000. However, the amount payable by such consumers after allowing admissible concessions could be allowed to be accepted in three equal monthly instalment upto June, 2001.
