ORDER

Sub : Regarding recovery of line dismantling charges from large industrial consumers being permanently disconnected and recovery of cost of releasing of service line from consumers seeking reconnection after two months from the date of disconnection.

The Coordination Committee in its 68th meeting held on 24-3-04,31-3-04 and 1-4-04 has discussed the proposals and approved the following: -

- (1) The dismantling charges of an electric line, which becomes redundant after disconnection, should not be borne by the consumer and be borne by the Nigam.
- (2) In cases where the service line has already been removed after disconnection, the total charges to be recovered for reconnection will include cost of dismantling of old line and total cost of erection of the new line (including the cost of material + overhead charges) less the cost of retrieved useful material from the old line.
- (3) In cases where the service line has not been removed, the cost of service line is not required to be recovered. Even if, the cost of service line has been refunded before disconnection as per earlier provisions, no charges be recovered from consumers at the time of reconnection if the service line is still existing.
- (4) The procedure at Sr. No. 2 & 3 may be followed till new General Conditions of Supply is approved by RERC, comes into force.
