**ORDER**

**Sub : Issue of notice for disconnection of connection of  
Defaulting consumers.**

In accordance with the provisions under Sub-section (1) of Section-24 of the Indian Electricity Act-1910, a notice of clear seven days in writing is required to be given to the consumer who fails to make payment of energy bills within due date.

Now, since the Electricity Act-2003 has come into force this matter was considered by Coordination Committee in its 68<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 24-3-04, 31-3-04 and 1-4-04 in the light of provision contained under Section-56 of the Act it has been decided that for disconnection of a defaulting consumer on grounds of non payment of dues a notice of clear 15 (fifteen) days be given instead of 7 (seven) days as was done hither to and the connection should be disconnected after expiry of notice period.
