ORDER

**Sub.:- Levy of power factor incentive surcharge in light of
"Power Factor Clause" of Tariff for Supply of
Electricity - 2001.**

It was prescribed vide order No.JP Discom/Dy.CE(C)/XEN/C.I/F.4(210)/Pt.VI/D.162 Dt.21.4.04 (JPR5-183), that while calculating the average power factor, value computed upto two digits only after decimal, need be taken and the third digit after decimal is to be ignored.

On representation from various Industrial Associations & Industries, the matter was again considered by the coordination committee in its 70th meeting held on 29.5.2004. After detailed discussions it has been decided that the procedure prescribed vide order No.JPR5-183 Dt.21.4.04 is not to be followed & instead the procedure being followed prior to issue of order No. JPR5-183 shall be continued to be followed. Accordingly, if the 3rd digit is 5 & above then the next higher stage of power factor be taken and if the 3rd digit is less than 5 then lower stage of power factor be taken.

As an illustration if the power factor is computed as 0.955, it should be rounded off to two places of decimal and taken as 0.96. However, if it is 0.954, the same should be taken as 0.95. Similarly, if the average power factor is 0.836 it should be rounded off to 0.84 whereas if it is 0.834 it should be taken as 0.83.

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The order No.JPR5-183 dt.21.4.2004 shall stand withdrawn. The bills issued in accordance with order No.JPR5-183 dt.21.4.2004 be revised accordingly.
