ORDER

Sub: Regarding procedure for release of connection to Police department's offices/colonies.

Procedure was prescribed for release of connection to the Police department's offices/colonies vide order No.RSEB/DCO/C/F.4/(205)/D.960 dt. 01-7-2000 (Comml.-519). Subsequently the said procedure was modified vide Tariff Order 2001 issued by RERC. Such provision is appearing under "Applicability" of tariff under Domestic service (Schedule DS/LT-1). Abstract of the provisions under said applicability is reproduced as under:-

"In case of quarters/colonies of Railways, Military, Police, Government Projects & similar residential colonies/complexes, the tariff shall be the same as that of domestic supply tariff for consumption above 50 units and first slab of energy charges will not apply but a rebate of 10% will be given for Fixed and Energy charges as well as Minimum Billing applicable for URBAN AREA, for taking supply at single point and in lieu of maintaining their own distribution system and also for effecting billing and revenue collection from each consumer. Fixed charges and Minimum Billing payable under domestic urban supply tariff shall be multiplied by number of dwelling units, shops and water supply pumping unit. Upto 5 KW pumping load for water supply and 5% of number of dwelling units for shops subject to maximum of five, shall be permitted to be charged at this tariff."

It has been reported that the above provisions of tariff are not being followed in the field in its true spirit. It is, therefore, reiterated that the provisions laid down under applicability of domestic service (Schedule DS/LT-1) as mentioned above should be followed strictly by all field officers.
