
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Sub.:- Segregation of Industrial load from Rural and other load.

The Jaipur Discom has taken up "Industrial Focus Programme" under which proposed segregation of industrial load from rural and other loads is to be executed at Discom's cost. The policy in such matters however, was not clearly defined.

The matter was put up in 90th meeting of the Coordination committee held on 24th January, 2006. After discussions, with regard to segregation of industrial load from rural and other loads it has been decided that following norms be adopted for such segregation :-

- (i) The segregation on the feeder be allowed in case there is large number of agriculture consumers connected to that feeder.
- (ii) The industrial energy (For SIP, MIP & Large Industrial Consumers) billed/sold on the feeder is more than 50% of total energy sold on this feeder to all consumers.
- (iii) The segregation of industrial feeder/rural feeders in industrial areas be done as per industrial focus programme. Segregation of feeders supplying power to industries in rural areas be done on 'FRP' pattern and in urban areas as per the pattern of 'urban focus programme'.


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
