CLARIFICATION

Sub: Amnesty Scheme for all categories of consumers

In order to clear the outstanding dues from consumers disconnected up to or before 31.3.05 and for the running consumers an Amnesty scheme duly approved by RERC was announced vide Order JPR-318. It has been felt that in case the disconnected consumers opt for availing the relief announced in the above mentioned Amnesty scheme and clear the outstanding dues and in case their electric connections are not reconnected there will exist every possibility of pilferage of electricity by such consumers.

In order to circumvent this problem, it has been decided that in case disconnected consumers clear the outstanding dues in terms of the Amnesty Scheme referred to above, their electricity connections be also reconnected if they so wish. This facility, however is to be allowed to Agricultural consumers only in line with the prevailing Agricultural Policy for the release of connections as prevailing. For other categories, the reconnection facility is to be allowed irrespective of the provisions under clause-47 of TCS-04.

This bears the approval of Managing Director, Jaipur Discom.
