After depositing the first instalment, if the consumer fails to deposit the balance instalments as per agreed time schedule under this concessional package, this facility shall be available for the balance outstanding amount. With a view to recover outstanding dues from Local Bodies & Govt. Departments, it has been decided to allow following concessional package. The facility would be available from 25th August, 2001 to 30th September, 2001.
