ORDER

Sub.:- Amendment in the "Tariff for Supply of Electricity 2001".

In pursuance of Rajasthan Electricity Regulatory Commission, Jaipur's order dt.10.10.2001 the following amendment are issued in the "Tariff for Supply of Electricity 2001" of Jaipur Discom effective from 1.4.2001.

In the said "TARIFF FOR SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY - 2001" in the "PREAMBLE" :-

1. The Sub-Para 20(iii) of Para III, shall be substituted by the following, namely :-

(iii) **"During the off-seasonal period, not exceeding four months in a year, fixed charges shall be charged at 25% of normal rate of fixed charges while energy charges shall be charged on actual consumption basis".**

2. The Sub Para 20(iv) of Para -III, shall be substituted by the following, namely:-

(iv)

“Consumption during any month in the off-seasonal period shall not exceed 25% (Twenty Five Percent) of the average monthly consumption of preceding seasonal period. In case it exceeds such limits during any month of the off-seasonal period then the total energy consumption during that month shall be charged at one and a half times of the normal rate of energy charges in addition to off-seasonal fixed charges.

The charges billed to the consumer during entire off-seasonal period shall not be counted towards seasonal minimum billing leviable for seasonal period.”

In the said “TARIFF FOR SUPPLY FOR ELECTRICITY – 2001” in the “LOW TENSION TARIFF” Part-I of the tariff structure: -

3. The clause (d) denoting “Minimum Billing” under “Small Industrial Service (Schedule SP/LT-5)” shall be substituted by the following, namely :-

(d) Minimum Billing :

‘Rs.140/- per HP/Month of sanctioned connected load.

For approved seasonal industries minimum billing shall be seasonal i.e. per season of 8 months (i.e. 8 x Minimum Billing Per Month)

The billing shall be done on monthly basis dividing the seasonal minimum billing by eight or actual consumption for that month whichever is higher. However the monthly charges so recovered shall be adjusted in the seasonal minimum billing for that season.

However, if the lighting load is within 10% limit but the total load including industrial load is beyond 25 HP, then the consumer can either come under Medium industrial Service category or he can take separate

light connection under Non-domestic Service category. Similarly, if the lighting load is beyond 10% limit but the total load is within 25 HP then also he can take a separate light connection under non-domestic Service category."

4. The clause (d) denoting "Minimum Billing" under "Medium Industry Service (Schedule MP/LT-6)" shall be substituted by the following, namely :-

(d) Minimum Billing :

"For approved seasonal industries minimum billing shall be seasonal i.e. per season of 8 months (i.e. 8 x Minimum Billing Per Month)

The billing shall be done on monthly basis dividing the seasonal minimum billing by eight or actual consumption for that month whichever is higher. However the monthly charges so recovered shall be adjusted in the seasonal minimum billing for that season."

In the said "TARIFF FOR SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY - 2001" in the "HIGH TENSION TARIFF" Part-II of the tariff structure: -

5. Clause (d) denoting "Minimum Billing" under "Large Industry Service (Schedule LP/HT-1)" except the note below that shall be substituted by the following, namely :-

(d) Minimum Billing :

"For approved seasonal industries minimum billing shall be seasonal i.e. per season of 8 months (i.e. 8 x Minimum Billing Per Month) .

The billing shall be done on monthly basis dividing the seasonal minimum billing by eight or actual consumption for that month whichever is higher. However the monthly charges so recovered shall be adjusted in the seasonal minimum billing for that season."

It is also to clarify that in case the seasonal period of any industry was continuing on 1.4.2001 and had expired subsequently, the amount of minimum charges are required to be computed by working out the minimum charges payable including meter rent and fixed service charges according to the Tariff prevalent before 1.4.2001 for the period of season prior to 1.4.2001 and for the period of season after April 1, on the basis of minimum billing in force after 1.4.2001 and by adding up the two sums so arrived at
