ORDER

Sub: Rationalisation/fixing uniform rates of rent of 11/0.4 KV transformer to be recovered from consumers.

As per provisions of "Tariff for Supply of Electricity-2001" consumers exceeding the contract demand/connected load of 50 KVA/50 KW are required to take supply on HT for which they have to install 11/0.4 KV distribution transformer. In some cases, consumers are not able to provide their own 11/0.4 KV transformer and opt for taking Nigam's transformer on rent. For such consumers, presently the Nigam provides the transformer and in lieu of that, the rent @ 3% of the cost of the transformer and DP is recovered on monthly basis.

It has been observed that due to different construction practices and, different cost of transformer and DP, field officers are charging different rental charges towards rent of transformer and DP from consumers.


The matter regarding recovery of uniform rates of transformer rent from the consumers was, therefore, discussed in the 30th meeting of the Co-Ordination Committee held on 3rd Nov'2001 wherein it was decided that a uniform rent be charged towards transformer and DP from various categories of consumers at the following rates:-

1. For contract demand up to: Rs. 2500/- p.m
60 KVA
2. For contract demand up to: Rs. 3000/p.m
100 KVA.
3. For contract demand above : Rs. 4000/p.m
100 KVA but up to 160 KVA
4. Above 160 KVA contract : On actual i.e. @3%
of the cost of Tr.
and D.P.

It was further decided that the above mentioned rates shall remain valid up to 30th June 2002 and thereafter the same would be reviewed in case the cost of transformer and DP increases considerably.

The above instructions shall come into force with effect from the billing month of Dec 2001.
