ORDER

Sub : "Amnesty Scheme" for realisation of outstanding dues from Municipalities Local Bodies & Govt. Department.

With a view to recovery outstanding dues from Local Bodies & Govt. Departments, it has been decided to allow following concessional package. The facility would be available from 6th May, 2002 to 31st May, 2002.

Brief Description	Concession Allowed
<u>Clearance of outstanding dues as on 31.3.2002</u>	
(i) If the total outstanding dues is paid in lumpsum upto 31.5.2002.	Entire DPS/LPS/interest shall be waived off and only principal amount of outstanding shall be recovered.
(ii) Cases where the consumer is not in a position to deposit the total outstanding dues in lumpsum and CMD has permitted to deposit the outstanding in three equal monthly instalments on merits of the case. However in such cases also first instalment should be deposited on or before 31.5.2002 to avail the benefit of scheme.	---do---

Note: (circle-wise) shall be communicated by the concerned Superintending Engineer weekly to the Chief Accounts Officer, Jaipur Discom, Jaipur with a copy to the Addl. Chief Engineer (Comml.), Jaipur Discom, Jaipur in respect of Principal amount recovered DPS/LPS waived and dues to be recovered in instalments. Break-up of dues into Nigam's dues & Electricity Duty may also be intimated seperately.

Terms & Conditions

- i) The Scheme shall be made available from 6.5.2002 to 31.5.2002.
- ii) The scheme shall be applicable irrespective of whether the disconnected consumer wants reconnection or not.
- iii) To avail these concessions, the consumer shall voluntarily undertake to withdraw all the Court cases, if any, pending in any court of law/ Consumer Forum/MRTP Commission etc. related to the outstanding dues.
- iv) After depositing the first instalment, if the consumer fails to deposit the balance instalments as per agreed time schedule under this concessional package, this facility shall be withdrawn for the balance outstanding amount.
- v) These concessional package will not be applicable for the amount of assessment made against theft of electricity or malpractice.
- vi) For availing these concessional package the consumer shall be required to apply on plain paper with the concerned Asstt. Engineer.
- vii) The outstanding dues should be worked out without taking into consideration the adjustment of existing security deposit. However, adjustment of security deposit may be made for disconnected consumers on the dues so worked out as on date of disconnection. From such consumers revised security deposit shall be obtained as per rules before reconnection, if any.
