
ORDER

Sub : Deciding the cases expeditiously registered with various level Settlement Committees.

Vide order No. JP Discom/CE (C)/XEN/C.I/F.1 (29)/D.1288 dt. 28-8-2002 it was clarified that in cases of theft of energy respective Settlement Committees can entertained cases only after consumer deposits 50% of the amount assessed. The Chairman of the respective Settlement Committee(s) is authorised to grant stay only for the recovery of balance 50% in full or part. It was also stated that the stay should be granted for the one month period at the first instance and it should be ensured by the concerned Settlement Committee to settle the case within one month of registration of the case. However, if it is not possible to settle the case within one month period of stay already granted, can be extended suitably upto the maximum period of 4 months i.e. in further three spans of one month each.

The matter was discussed in the meeting held on 26-8-2002 to review the performance of circle officers and it has been reported that in many cases which are registered only after accepting 50% of the billed amount and stay is granted for remaining 50% are not decided for a long period. It is, therefore, once again requested that in the cases of theft of energy where the stay has been for remaining 50% amount must be decided within a period of one month from the date of its registration. It was decided that a list of all pending cases be sent to Corporate office by 8-9-02 but this office has not received such information from any of the field officers. It is, therefore, requested to send a list of all pending cases so as to reach corporate office by 25-9-02 positively by fax.
