ORDER

Sub : Levy of transformer rent as well as transformation losses from the consumers having sanctioned connected load above 60 HP and contract demand more than 50 KVA with supply on LT and to whom connections were released prior to 7-8-90.

In accordance with the existing provisions, the consumers under MIP category having contract demand more than 50 KVA are required to pay transformer rent as per JPR5-88 in case Nigam's transformer is taken on rent. In such cases transformation losses @ 3% per month are recovered from them. However, MIP consumers to whom the connections were released prior to 7-8-90 are required to pay the transformer rent on concessional rates in slabs as prescribed vide Order No. Comml-428 dt. 23-2-99 instead of order No. JPR5-88 dt. 18-10-02. However, 3% transformation losses are not being levied in such cases in accordance with the instructions issued vide Order No. Comml.363 dt. 13.4.98.

The matter has been discussed in 49th meeting of the Coordination Committee held on 30-11-02 wherein it was decided that from the consumer under MIP categories whose connections were released prior to 7-8-90 and causing maximum demand more than 50 KVA having sanctioned connected load upto 150 HP with metering on LT side, shall continue to pay the transformer rent in accordance with the instructions already issued vide No. Comml-428 dt. 23-2-99. Such consumers, however, shall also be required to pay the transformation losses @ 3% per month chargeable on the basis of recorded units.

Above instructions are issued in supersession of erstwhile Board's Order No. Comml.-363 and earlier orders issued on the subject and shall be applicable with effect from the billing month of January, 2003.
