**ORDER**

While reviewing the progress of recovery for the year 2010-11, it has been observed that excluding the PSL category, level of collection efficiency is not satisfactory and up to the mark. Such a poor performance has been viewed seriously and action is likely to be initiated against the defaulters, after completion of the detailed analysis, in depth.

Certain Superintending Engineers were however of the view that one of the reasons of poor collection efficiency is liquidity problem with the agriculture consumers. They were further of the view that since crop is ready to be sold in the market, 100% collection efficiency could be achieved by the end of April, 2011, if the same is measured for 13 months i.e. April, 2010 to April, 2011 and the field officers are given a chance to accept this challenge.

Accordingly, the matter has been considered and following instructions are hereby conveyed for strict compliance by the all concerned:-

- I. The revenue recovery campaign will continue for one more month i. e. April, 2011.
- II. The vehicle and men power provided extra, will continue to be provided during this period.
- III. The field officers will ensure to disconnect the premises of all defaulting consumers physically, except the Govt. connections.
- IV. The field officers will further ensure frequent and periodical visit of the premises disconnected, to avoid misuse.
- V. Since Principal Secretary (PHED) has already directed to his field officers to clear all pending dues of the distribution companies, all possible steps be taken to ensure that amount relating to energy bills and undertakings, yet outstanding against the PHED is realized against new budget.

- VI. As per Govt. order, the PSL bills of municipal bodies could be adjusted to the extent of energy consumed during the F.Y. 2009-10. Under such circumstances, a large amount might be outstanding against the municipal bodies, besides of connections under other categories. All possible efforts are needed to ensure recovery of such dues.
- VII. Apart from the PHED and municipal bodies, recovery may also be pending against the Police, Medical & Health, Education and other Govt. departments, the matter may be taken with the counter parts of such departments and all out efforts be made to liquidate such dues.
- VIII. List of outstanding dues as on 31.03.2011, against the Govt. connections will be prepared by the field officers department wise (inclusive of PSL & municipal bodies) separately. The list so prepared should further reflect the recovery made by personal efforts during April, 2011 and amount remains pending at the ~~month~~ end along with reasons thereof in brief and provided to corporate office by the SE(s) concerned, latest by 07.05.2011.

All concerned are, therefore, advised to take above challenge and show their best of ability by 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2011.
