ORDER

Sub:- Recovery of old arrears from PDC consumers under EUDR Act and Land Revenue Act – and Incentive thereof.

With a view to promote speedy recovery of old arrears from PDC consumers under EUDR Act and Land Revenue Act, the issue of incentive payable to officers/officials and to Technical Workmen, who are directly involved in recovery of outstanding dues under EUDR Act and Land Revenue Act was discussed in the 33th meeting of the Discom Co-ordination Forum held on 16.2.12 and it was decided to allow incentive @ 3% of the recovered amount from PDC consumers under EUDR Act & additional incentive 3%, if the recovery has been effected from PDC consumers under LR Act, as appearing in the books of accounts on 31.3.2011. This scheme will come into force w.e.f. 1st April, 2012 and would be applicable for the recoveries to be made during the year 2012-13.


1. The above Incentive will be payable to those field functionaries who made personal efforts under EUDR & LR Act, and will not be applicable for the followings:-
 - (i) Amount recovered from the consumer and deposited by/ recovered from official liquidator BIFR, RICCO, RFC, Bank & other financial institutions, etc.
 - (ii) Payments received through adjustment
 - (iii) Amount voluntarily deposited/dues liquidated by/from the consumer on re-connection/new connection
2. Maximum incentive payable under the scheme will however be limited up to Rs.50,000/- in each case/consumer.
3. The incentive amount shall be distributed as under:
 - a) For the amount recovered under EUDR Act:-
 - i) 50% of admissible incentive amount equally amongst AFN concerned JEN and ARO
 - ii) Remaining 50% of admissible incentive amount equally amongst concerned Meter Reader, Ledger Keeper and Tech Workmen

b) For the amount recovered under Land Revenue Act

- i) 35% of admissible incentive amount equally amongst AEN concerned JEN and ARO
- ii) 35% of admissible incentive amount equally amongst Meter Reader Ledger Keeper and Tech Workmen
- iii) Remaining 30% of admissible incentive amount equally amongst XEN his concerned staff and L A O. In case there is no role of L A O, incentive shall be distributed equally amongst XEN and his concerned staff.

4. In all such cases, incentive will be sanctioned by the Circle SE. A separate register/list of such PDC consumers will be maintained by the unit officers to avoid any double/wrong payment of incentive and also for further verification by the Internal Audit parties
5. The above rates and procedure of incentive shall be applicable for the recoveries made during the year 2012-13 only and subject to further review
