

C I R C U L A R

RERC award dated 21.3.01 provides for allowing 5% rebate on billed amount to the consumers whose meter remained defective for more than 2 months. To compile separately, the amount of such rebate and to account for the same, following directions are issued :-

1. The amount of rebate shall be compiled under a new transaction code 48 and shown in column 29(a) "rebate" of MIS 3.1 and shall be booked to accounting head. "Rebate to consumers on account stopped/defective meters-78.827."
2. Codewise list, as being provided to the unit officers, will also include list of 5% rebate allowed.
3. The computer agency will provide an abstract of such rebate, showing categorywise, sub-divisions, No. of meter and amount allowed as rebate to the Chief Accounts Officer, Jaipur Discom, every month.


