ORDER

Sub:- Adoption of Government of Rajasthan's Notification No. F.1 (4) FD/ Rules/ 98 dated 12.12.2012, regarding Rule 91 of Rajasthan Service Rules, 1951 in respect of advance credit of Privilege Leave and consequential amendments in the regulations of the Nigam.

The Coordination Committee in 163rd Meeting held on 15.02.2013 has accorded approval for adoption of Finance Department, Government of Rajasthan's notification No. F.1 (4) FD/ Rules/ 98 dated 12.12.2012, for all the employees including Technical workmen of the Nigam, making it effective from 1.1.2013.

Accordingly, the following proviso shall be inserted at the end of Regulation 45.2. (a) in the JdVVNL Employees Service Regulations, namely:-


"Provided that where the privilege leave at the credit of a Nigam employee as on the last day of December or June is 300 days or less but more than 285 days, the advance credit of 15 days privilege leave on the first day of January or July shall be made as per provisions contained in sub-clause (i) of clause (a) above and the leave account of such advance credited privilege leave shall be kept separately and against which privilege leave taken by a Nigam employee during the half year shall first be adjusted during that half year and balance, if any, shall be credited to the leave account at the end of the half year, subject to the condition that balance of such advance credited privilege leave plus privilege leave already at credit do not exceed the maximum limit of 300 days."

Also, the following proviso shall be inserted at the end of Rule 12 (c) in the Rajasthan Electrical & Mechanical and Water Works Department Technical Employees Leave Rule, 1955:-

"Provided that where the privilege leave at the credit of a Nigam technical workmen as on the last day of December or June is 300 days or less but more than 285 days, the advance credit of 15 days privilege leave on the first day of January or July shall be made as per provisions contained in clause (c) and the leave account of such advance credited privilege leave shall be kept separately and against which privilege leave taken by a Nigam technical workmen during the half year shall first be adjusted during that half year and balance, if any, shall be credited to the leave account at the end of the half year, subject to the condition that balance of such advance credited privilege leave plus privilege leave already at credit do not exceed the maximum limit of 300 days."

This is subject to ratification by the Board of Directors.
