ORDER- 360

Sub:-Increase in Privilege Leave admissible to Technical Workmen.

The Board of Directors, JdVVNL, in its 88 meeting held on 29.11.05 has decided to increase the Privilege Leave from 18 days to 24 days in one calendar year & accumulation limit of Privilege Leave from 60 days to 180 days, w.e.f. 1st July 2005, in respect of Technical Workmen (other than drawing staff & light vehicle drivers). Accordingly the existing Rule No. 10(a), (b) (c) and 12 (c) of the Rajasthan Electrical & Mechanical & Water Works Department Technical Leave Rules, 1959, as adopted by the RSEB/JdVVNL shall be substituted as follows, namely:

(I) Rule 10: Accounts of Privilege Leave and Casual leave:

Subject to provisions of these rules, employee may be granted privilege and casual leave as follows during a calendar year:

(a)	Permanent Employees	24 days privilege leave and 15 days casual leave
(b)	Temporary Employees	24 days privilege leave. The admissibility of 15 days casual leave to temporary employees will be as per foot notes of this rule. as reproduced below:-

(II) Rule No.12: Accumulation of Privilege leave:

(c) Privilege leave not availed of in a calendar year shall be carried forward to the next calendar year, subject to the condition that the total number of days of privilege leave that may be carried forward from any calendar year to a succeeding calendar year shall not exceed 180 days.

- (i) Casual leave as per rules will be admissible to the employees, who have put in two years continuous service (instead of three years) as here to force, vide govt. order No.F.17(139)PW/61 dated 9.12.61.
- (ii) Sec.79 of the Factories Act, 1948, will apply in the matter of grant of leave to casual labourers. "Vide letter No.RSEB/F.2/Estt.19(18) 403 dated 19.9.62 from the Asstt. Secretary RSEB, Jaipur to the Chief
