ORDER**Sub: Tariff applicability for chambers of advocates situated in the Court premises.**

The issue regarding applicability of tariff for the chambers of the Advocates which are situated in the Court's campus (in the premises of Courts) has been recently decided by the National Commission, New Delhi in case No.352/96 filed by Shri Gopal Das Bhargava wherein JVVNL had challenged the same by filing revision petition in National Commission, New Delhi. It has been decided by the Court that the Chambers of the Advocates situated in the court's complex say High Court, District Court and other courts should be treated as "Non Domestic installation" and therefore, there is no justification for applying domestic tariff for such installation which was the contention raised by the Advocates.

The National Forum has decided this case in line with the case of JVVNL Vs Sajjan Lal Surana in respect of which directions were issued by order Comml.JDP/490. I am, therefore, directed to advise to please ensure that correct tariff is made applicable (NDS tariff) for the connections of Advocates' Chambers situated in the High Court, District Court and other courts. For the past period, if the domestic tariff was made applicable due to any reason instead of correct tariff which is NDS tariff, the difference of both tariffs i.e. Non Domestic (NDS/LT-2) and Domestic (DS/LT-1) should be recovered from such connection holders. The limitation of time period for recovery of such old dues up to two years in light of Clause 49 of TCOS-2004 be kept in view.

The above instructions should be strictly complied with by all concerned.
