ORDER

Sub: Amendment in "Terms & Conditions for Supply of Electricity-2004".

It has come to the notice that large industrial Power Consumers under special fortnightly billing category are taking undue benefit when the cheque deposited bounces back. The cheque(s) is/are timely deposited on counter of Bill Collecting Agency authorized by the Nigam but the payment information is received late in concern Sub-Division and during transit period the consumer again makes payments of energy bill against dishonored Cheque's. In such case the power supply could not be disconnected and the very purpose of supplementary agreement is defeated.

To curb such practice the following provision is added at the end of proviso, under Part-II "Security" Clause-3(1) of TCOS-2004, mentioned in Comml.JDP/420 dtd 03.11.07:-

"In case, the Cheque issued by a consumer is returned by the Bank more than twice, apart from the disconnection the facility of payment by Cheque will be withdrawn. Once the facility is withdrawn that will not be restored back before 12 months and the consumer will require to pay one and half months Security in cash and will be billed on ordinary fortnightly basis."
