

**JODHPUR VIDYUT VITRAN NIGAM LIMITED**

ORDER

Sub: Change of category from SIP to MIP in eventualities when the maximum demand exceeds 18.65KW for more than two times in a financial year.

As per provisions of Tariff, the Small Industrial Service(Schedule-SP/LT-5) is applicable for consumer having aggregate connected load not exceeding 25HP including admissible lighting load and Medium Industrial Service(Schedule-MP/LT-6) is applicable for aggregate connected load above 25HP(18.65KW). Presently 3 phase static(10-60 Amps.) energy meters are installed in case of 3 phase SIP connections. These meters also display the maximum demand in KVA/KW. While going through the billing data of such SIP connections it has been reported that a number of small industrial consumers are having connected load more than 25HP but are still being billed under SIP category. Notably, the tariff for small industrial tariff is low as compared to medium industrial tariff, as a result thereof, consumers tend to remain under the applicability of small industrial tariff schedule. In such cases the revenue of the Nigam is adversely affected due to applicability of lower tariff instead of higher tariff applicable for MIP category.

In addition to above some queries were also raised by various field officers for clarifying the matter under different situations.

To allay the doubts & to have uniform and correct application of the Nigams existing provisions for small industrial consumers(SIP) who have exceeded the maximum demand above 18.65 KW more than two times in a financial year, the following guidelines are issued to deal with such cases:-

1. Whenever a small industrial consumer exceeds maximum demand above 18.65 KW two times in the same financial year then on 2nd occurrence a notice shall be given by the concerned Assistant Engineer to the consumer for information and awareness clearly stating that your maximum demand have increased two times during this financial year 1st in the month of _____ and 2nd in the month of _____. This indicates that your connected load is more than your sanctioned load. Now, if your demand shall exceed for the 3rd time in any month (during this financial year) your category would be changed to MIP by considering highest recorded Maximum Demand out of 3 occurrences as your connected load and billing would be done accordingly for a minimum period of 12 months.

After expiry of 12 months if you wish you can apply for load reduction as per the clause 39 of TCOS-2004.

2. Financial year is considered as consumption months from April to March.
3. The Billing for the months in which Maximum Demand exceeded 1st and 2nd time shall be as per the tariff under which the connection was existing.
4. Action regarding augmentation of system including proper metering should also be taken by field officers accordingly.
5. The amount of additional security is to be recovered if security against two months consumption is less.

Illustration:

- i) Suppose the sanctioned load of consumer is : 25HP(18.65KW)
- ii) The demand was increased above 18.65KW(25HP) in the month of

June,2010	:20KW
Sept.,2010	:30KW
Jan.,2011	:25KW
- iii) Notice is to be issued to consumer in the month of :Oct.,2010
- iv) The billing with demand more than 18.65KW will be started by taking 30KW load as connected load till 12 months i.e. up to Jan. 2012(i.e. Feb. 2011 to Jan.,2012)

Billing in MIP category shall be started from the billing month of Feb.,2011 and continue minimum up to Jan.,2012

- v) Billing for the month June,2010 & Sept.,2010 will be done on small industrial tariff under which the connection was existing.

This order is issued in supersession to earlier order No.Comml.JDP/255 dtd 19.02.05 & Comml.JDP/280 dtd 25.06.05 and field officers are advised to follow the above instructions with immediate effect.

The above instructions/directions/clarifications has been issued with the approval of Hon'ble Managing Director, Jodhpur Discom, Jodhpur.
