### CIRCULAR

**Sub: “Amnesty Scheme” for disconnected consumers of all categories (disconnected upto or prior to 31.03.2015) for realization of outstanding dues.**

With a view to recover the outstanding dues from disconnected consumers of all categories (disconnected up to or prior to 31.03.2015 and not reconnected till application of amnesty scheme) it has been decided to allow concessional package for a period of 15.07.2016 to 30.09.2016 to such disconnected consumers.

The concessional package shall be applicable for the disconnected consumers of all categories (disconnected upto or prior to 31.03.2015) with the terms & conditions as below:

1. This scheme shall be available for the period w.e.f.15.07.2016 to 30.09.2016 for all category consumers lying disconnected upto and prior to 31.03.2015.
2. The Amnesty Scheme shall not be available to the consumers who have already availed benefit from such schemes in last 5 years.
3. For availing the concession package, the consumer shall require to apply to the concerned Assistant Engineer for all categories except large industrial category. In case of LIP, they will have to apply to the Accounts Officer (HTB) / Billing Authority in the format enclosed at Annexure- ‘A’.
4. i) Onetime payment to be deposited, if the principal outstanding amount is upto Rs.5 Lacs as on 31.03.2015 with 100% waiver of LPS/DPS (charged till disconnection) /Interest amount (Chargeable from the date of disconnection to the date of payment of outstanding amount).
- ii) If the outstanding amount is more than 5 Lacs then up-front payment of Rs.5 Lacs or 25 % of the principal outstanding amount whichever is higher including full ED shall be deposited by the consumer after waiving 100% LPS/DPS/Interest. For remaining balance principal amount concerned AEN(O&M) is authorized to

allow suitable monthly installments so as to recover the balance amount within 5 months from the date of allowing installments. However, in case of LIP consumers such powers shall be exercised by Accounts Officer (HTB) / billing authority.

5. The benefit of Amnesty Scheme shall be admissible only on complying the provisions contained in para 4 (i) & (ii) in prescribed time limit. Failure to adhere installment schedule in any month, full LPS / DPS / Interest shall be chargeable from such consumers and no benefit of the Amnesty Scheme shall be passed on.
6. This scheme shall be applicable irrespective of whether disconnected consumer wants reconnection or not.
7. The disconnected agriculture connections shall be reconnected in accordance with the prevailing provisions of Agriculture Policy. The disconnected connections of other categories shall be reconnected if feasible as per prevailing Nigam's rules.
8. The disconnected consumers will be allowed reconnection after depositing the full up-front amount and reconnection charges along-with cost of laying any additional line required and payment of security charges separately as per prevailing rules.
9. This scheme shall not be applicable for the amount of assessment made against theft of electricity and/ or malpractices.
10. If a case, pending with any Court of Law and consumer desires to avail benefit of amnesty scheme, he can do so by depositing full principal amount as per scheme & on production of an undertaking to the effect that he will withdraw the court case within a month's time and produce the withdrawal acceptance from the court.
11. In case consumer has dispute with respect to the principal amount & desires to settle first, he may approach to the respective Settlement Forum and after obtaining decision of the Settlement Forum, can avail benefits of Amnesty Scheme, provided he produce an undertaking while approaching the Settlement Forum with regards to acceptance of settlement decision and withdrawal of court case, if any. The meetings of consumer Grievance Redressal & Settlement Forum will be held on weekly basis during the scheme period. The respective forum will ensure to dispose of the grievances timely during this period.


