ORDER**Sub: Use of Energy Efficient and Energy Saving
Devices to reduce the peak load demand.**

To reduce the peak load demand, the Jodhpur Discom has taken a decision to encourage only the rural and urban Domestic, Street Light, Hospitals, Schools/ Educational Institutions, Government Offices/Buildings categories of consumers to use Energy Efficient and Energy Saving devices. Although, installation of Energy Efficient devices is a costly affair but there are certain firms in the market who are willing to install the same on the basis of deferred payment scheme at the consumer's premises on the rates as mutually agreed by the consumer and the supplier firm. The Jodhpur Discom will approve such firms after examining these products. The Jodhpur Discom has agreed to collect the instalment of deferred payment with its energy bills.

Jodhpur Discom will nominate such firms to operate in its area on the following terms and conditions:


1. The firms will be approved by the Jodhpur Discom..
2. Such approved firms shall execute an agreement in the prescribed proforma on Non Judicial Stamp of Rs.100.00. The copy of agreement is attached as Annexure-"A". The S.E.(Comml.) shall execute the agreement on behalf of Jodhpur Discom.
3. The approved firm shall execute an agreement with the willing consumers of Jodhpur Discom for installation of energy efficient devices on mutually agreed rates.
4. The firm will produce the authority letter of the consumer for the recovery of deferred payment through its energy bill, agreed between firm and consumer to the concerned Assistant Engineer of the Jodhpur Discom. On receipt of authority letter, the sub divisional officer will

inform to the billing agency for the charging of monthly instalment of deferred payment through energy bills.

5. The firm will deposit a sum of Rs.5.00 per energy efficient device/fluorescent tube light with the sub divisional officer of Jodhpur Discom as processing charge alongwith the authority letter.
6. The collection charges @ 6% on the collected amount shall be charged by Jodhpur Discom and after deducting collection charges, remaining amount (Net amount) payable to firm shall be remitted to the firm within 45 days after billing cycle. No interest shall be payable.
7. The amount of deferred payment instalment as per agreement between consumer and firm will be charged in the bill of consumer in next bill provided the information is given by firm before 45 days in advance.
8. The amount received against the monthly energy bills shall be firstly adjusted against Nigam's dues and thereafter the instalment of deferred payment.
