ORDERSub.: Deposit of cash security by various categories of Industrial consumers.

Various associations of Industries have been representing against the existing provisions of cash security from industries. The matter has been considered in detail and the following decisions have been taken:-

1. Small (SIP) & Medium (MIP) consumers

- (i) SIP consumers, whose average monthly bill is Rs. 10,000/- or more and MIP consumers, whose average monthly bill is Rs. 25,000/- or more, may opt for depositing the energy bill on fortnightly billing basis. In such a case the requirement of security deposit shall be equivalent to only one and a half months (1.5 months) in cash instead of the existing provision of two months cash security.
- (ii) The fortnightly bills will be sent alongwith regular monthly energy bill, on the basis of consumption of previous month to be charged for net energy rates plus rate of fuel surcharge only. The date of issue of this fortnightly bill will be 15th of the month and shall be payable as per normal grace period. The payment made towards fortnightly bill shall be adjusted in the main monthly bill of the next month.
- (iii) Such consumers shall execute a special agreement to the effect that if they fail to deposit fortnightly bill and/or regular monthly bill by the prescribed due date(s), as the case may be, their connection could be disconnected immediately without the requirement of seven days notice prescribed under section 24(1) of Indian Electricity Act, 1910.


2. Large Industrial Consumers

Under this category in addition to the existing provisions of depositing security prescribed in the erstwhile Board's Order COMML-530 dated 19.7.2000, an option would be given to such consumers, whose monthly consumption is Rs. 10 lacs or more, to opt for depositing the energy bills in the following manner:-

- (i) Such units shall deposit the fortnightly bill by 23rd of the month in cash. The due date to deposit by cheque shall be 20th of the month.
- (ii) Such consumers shall deposit the regular energy bill on 8th of the billing month in cash. The due date to deposit by cheque shall be 5th of the month.
- (iii) Such consumers shall execute a supplementary agreement to the effect that if they fail to deposit fortnightly bill and/or regular monthly energy bill on the due date(s), as the case may be, in the manner prescribed above, their connection could be disconnected immediately, without the requirement of seven days notice prescribed under Section 24(1) of the Indian Electricity Act, 1910.
- (iv) In the above cases the requirement of security shall be limited to one month consumption in cash only.

The above order shall come into force with immediate effect. Such facility shall only be available to the consumers having no outstanding dues. However, in case any consumer under Small, Medium & Large Industrial categories who, after opting for this arrangement, defaults in making payment as stated herein above, besides disconnection, this facility will be withdrawn and such consumer will be required to pay two months security in cash and will be billed on monthly basis. Supplementary Agreement

Whereas the original agreement was executed on dated _____ 2000 (hereinafter called main agreement) between the earstwhile Board/Nigam and consumer for supply of ____ KVA power at voltage level of ____ KV for the purpose of manufacture of _____.

Whereas the consumer has opted to deposit security equivalent to one month's consumption in accordance with Nigam's Order No. _____ dt. _____ and consequently the consumer hereby agrees to make amendments in existing clause 16(a) and furtaher agreed to insert a new clause 16(aa) after amended clause 16 (a) of the main agreement as hereunder:-

Clause 16(a)

The consumer shall pay to the Nigam in the manner mentioned in clause 16(aa) below, charges for electrical energy supplied to the consumer under this agreement in accordance with the provisions &

scale of rates set forth in the tariff schedule attached hereto and which shall be deemed to be part of this agreement.

Clause 16(aa)

The consumer shall make payment of current consumption fortnightly on 23rd of the month by cash and regular energy bill on 8th of the billing month by cash after adjustment of fortnightly bill paid as above. In case of default in payment as above, the Nigam would be at liberty to disconnect the supply immediately on occurrence of such default without the requirement of further notice of 7 days before disconnection of supply as per section 24(1) of Indian Electricity Act, 1910.

SPECIAL AGREEMENT

This agreement made this _____ day of _____ 2000 between Jodhpur Vidhyut Vitran Nigam Limited (hereinafter called the 'Nigam' which expression shall where the context so admit include its successors in office and assigns) of the one part and M/S _____ (herein after called 'Consumer' which expression shall where the context so admit includes his successors, administrators' legal representatives, successors in business and assigns)

Whereas the original agreements was submitted through Application/Requisition/Agreement from (hereinafter called 'main' agreement) to the erstwhile Board/Nigam for supply of _____ KW/HP/KVA power at voltage level of _____ KV/Volts for an electric connection under Small/ Medium Industrial category bearing account No. _____ at consumer's premises situated at _____ (mention address).

AND WHEREAS the consumer now hereby agrees to execute special agreement as under:-

"Since the consumer has opted to pay security deposit on equivalent to One & a half months consumption charges instead of two months consumption charges in general and therefore, the consumer shall pay to the Nigam every fortnightly charges for electrical energy supplied to the consumer. In such an event two bills shall be issued on first day/billing day of every month. The energy consumed by the consumer during the first fort-

night shall be billed and payable by the consumer based on half the preceding month's consumption. The energy consumed during the second fortnight shall be billed and payable by the consumer on the basis of recorded consumption of the entire month minus the payment made towards the bill of first fortnight. The grace period shall be allowed in both cases as is allowed in monthly billing procedure. The consumer further agrees that if they fail to deposit the fortnightly bill and reegular monthly bill on the prescribed due date(s) their connection could be disconnected immediately without fulfilling the requirement of seven days notice as required under Section-24(1) of the Indian Electricity Act, 1910.
