ORDER

**Sub: "Amnesty Scheme" for industrial category of
Consumers for revival of industries-realisation
Of outstanding dues thereof.**

With a view to revive the sick/closed industrial units it has been decided to allow following concessional package for disconnected/running industrial consumers for a period from 15th June, 2003 to 15th July, 2003 :

Brief description	Concession Allowed
<p>1. Small & Medium Industrial category of consumers (running as well as disconnected)</p> <p>Clearance of outstanding dues as on 31-03-2002.</p> <p>i) If the consumer deposits (lumpsum the total outstanding dues on or before 15-07-2003.</p> <p>ii) If the consumer is unable to make the payment of outstanding dues in lumpsum then he could be given option to deposit dues as under:</p> <p>I) First instalment:</p> <p>50% of principal dues as on 31-03-2002 plus 12.5% DPS/Interest on total principal dues as on 31-03-2002 upto date of payment plus principal amount of outstanding dues accumulated alongwith DPS/Interest thereon during 1-4-2002 onwards.</p> <p>II) Balance dues in three equal monthly instalments.</p> <p>2. Large Industrial Category:</p> <p>A. Clearance of outstanding dues by industries lying disconnected prior to or on 31-03-2002.</p>	<p>Entire DPS/Interest shall be waived off on the outstanding as on 31-03-2002 and only principal amount of outstanding as on 31-03-2002 shall be recovered. The Principal dues accumulated during 2002-2003 shall be recovered alongwith DPS/Interest.</p> <p>Only 75% DPS/Interest shall be waived off on the outstanding dues as on 31-03-2002.</p>

<p>i) If the consumer deposits (Lumpsum) the total outstanding dues upto 15-07-2003</p>	<p>a) 50% LPS accumulated on dues other than arrear of fuel surcharge prior to disconnected period shall be waived</p>
<p>ii) If the consumer's connection is lying disconnected on or before 31-03-2002 and the consumer is unable to make the payment of outstanding dues in lumpsum then he could be given option to deposit 50% of outstanding upto 15-07-2003 and balance 50% in 6 monthly instalments</p>	<p>b) No LPS/Interest on outstanding arrears of fuel surcharge shall be charged from date of billing to the date of deposit of full amount on or before 15-07-2003.</p>
<p>B) Clearance of outstanding dues as on 31-03-2003 by industries not lying disconnected or lying disconnected after 31-03-2002.</p>	<p>c) 6% interest per annum on outstanding dues arrived at as per (a) above as on date of disconnection to date of depositing dues i.e. upto 15-07-2003 shall be recovered instead of usual interest of 18% p.a.</p>
<p>If the consumer deposit (lumpsum) the total outstanding dues on or before 15-07-2003.</p>	<p>a) 50% LPS prior to disconnected period shall be waived.</p>
	<p>b) Only 6% interest per annum on outstanding dues arrived at as para(a) above, as on date of disconnection to date of depositing 50% amount and for balance 50% amount to be deposited in 6 monthly instalments, 9% interest per annum shall be recovered on outstanding till payment of instalment.</p>
	<p>50% LPS accumulated on dues other than the outstanding arrear of fuel surcharge upto 31-03-2002 shall be waived and no LPS/Interest shall be charged on amount of arrears of fuel surcharge from date of billing.</p>
	<p>Plus the outstanding dues accumulated during 2002-2003 are payable alongwith DPS/Interest.</p>

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- i) The Scheme shall be made available for a period from 15-06-2003 to 15-07-2003.
- ii) Concerned Assistant Engineer is empowered for allowing rebate in DPS/Interest for the Small and Medium Industrial Category of consumers and for Large Industrial Category Superintending Engineer(Comml.) is empowered to allow rebate in LPS/Interest as per scheme.
- iii) The Scheme shall be applicable irrespective of whether the disconnected consumer wants reconnection or not.

- iv) To avail these concessions the consumer shall voluntarily undertake to withdraw all the court cases, if any, pending in any court of law/consumer Forum/MRTP Commission etc. related to the outstanding dues.
- v) If the consumer fails to deposit the amount as per agreed time schedule under this concessional package, this facility shall be withdrawn.
- vi) These concessional package will not be applicable for the amount of assessment made against theft of electricity or malpractice.
- vii) For availing these concessional package, the consumer shall be required to apply with the concerned Asstt.Engineer for the Small and Medium Industrial Category of consumers and with the Superintending Engineer(Comml.) for the Large Industrial Category of consumers in the format enclosed at ANNEXURE-"A".
- viii) These concessional package shall not be applicable for those consumers who have taken benefit of similar schemes of 1999 or 2000 or 2001 and 2002.
- ix) The outstanding dues should be worked out without taking into consideration the adjustment of existing security deposit. However, adjustment of security deposit may be made for disconnected consumers in the dues so worked out as on date of disconnection and from such consumers revised security deposit shall be obtained as per rules before reconnection, if any.
- x) Since DPS is not separately shown in outstanding dues in SIP and MIP consumers, the DPS shall have to be segregated from the outstanding dues and shall be waived either completely or 75% as the case may be, as per the scheme. However, where segregation of DPS from the outstanding dues is either not possible or likely to take much time, a rebate shall be allowed in the outstanding dues in lieu of DPS @ 1% or 0.75% per month as the case may be, i.e. 1% for cases where complete DPS is to be waived and 0.75% for cases where 75% of DPS is to be waived for the months (reckoning number of month(s) after August, 1997 as levy of DPS was started from August, 1997 only) since the dues are outstanding till date of disconnection (for the cases of connections lying disconnected) or till the consumer makes the payment (for running connection i.e. not lying disconnected).
- xi) Industrial connections of Govt. Departments like PHED etc. shall be governed under "Amnesty Scheme" issued separately for Local Bodies & Govt. Departments.
